


UNIFORM REMINDERS

What we're learning...

- ~ The Perfect System passive voice tenses are formed using the 4th principal part, also called a participle or verbal adjective, and a form of the verb sum
- ~ The perfect tense passive voice uses the present tense forms of sum
- ~ The 4th principal part of the verb is a regular 1st/2nd declension adjective with endings for all three genders
- ~ The perfect passive participle must match the subject in number and gender; the sum form must match the subject in person and number

What we're learning...

- ~ Meus, tuus, noster, and vester are used to show possession for 1st and 2nd person pronouns; they function as regular 1st/2nd declension adjectives
- ~ A noun has to be in the genitive case to be possessive, but possessive pronouns can be written in ALL cases



What we're learning...

~ 3rd declension m/f i-stem nouns have an "i" in the genitive plural; neuter i-stem nouns have an "i" in the genitive plural, as well as in the ablative singular and the nominative and accusative plural
~ Most i-stem nouns are one or two syllable words and either have the same number of syllables in the nominative and genitive singular, or the genitive singular stem ends in two consonants

What we're learning...

~ In Lesson 11, we will begin to change between fractions, decimals, and percents
~ When adding & subtracting mixed numbers, the whole numbers and fractions are added or subtracted separately
~ We will begin multiplying with mixed numbers, which will require each mixed number to be turned into an improper fraction before multiplying
~ When adding & Subtracting decimals, the decimals must be lined up; when multiplying decimals, decimal spaces are counted
