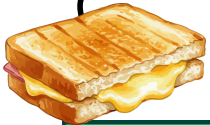

What we're learning...

- ~ The Perfect System passive voice tenses are formed using the 4th principal part, also called a participle or verbal adjective, and a form of the verb sum
- ~ The pluperfect tense passive voice uses the imperfect tense forms of sum
- ~ The 4th principal part of the verb is a regular 1st/2nd declension adjective with endings for all three genders
- ~ The perfect passive participle must match the subject in number and gender; the sum form must match the subject in person and number

What we're learning...

- ~ A preposition shows the relationship between a noun/pronoun and another word in the sentence
- ~ Latin prepositions are either governed by the accusative or the ablative case, meaning that depending on the preposition, the object of the preposition will either be in the accusative or the ablative case
- ~ Many Latin prepositions are translated by compound prepositions of two or more words in English

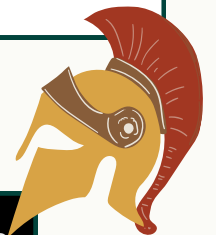

What we're learning...

~ There are two types of adjectives in Latin: 1st/2nd declension adjectives & 3rd declension adjectives.
~ 3rd declension adjectives have endings that are almost identical to the 3rd declension i-stem noun endings.
~ In reviewing the genitive case, the noun job of the genitive case is the Possessive Noun Adjective (PNA), and the genitive case is translated with an (") or the preposition "of".
