SCIENCE (Thursday)

How can you fill a balloon *without* using your breath, a helium tank, or a balloon pump? We'll hypothesize what might happen when we fill a bottle with vinegar, add baking powder to a balloon, put the balloon securely over the bottle opening, then sprinkle in the baking powder. We'll do the experiment and observe what happens: the carbon dioxide gas will cause the balloon to inflate. Helium is the gas that we typically use to fill a balloon if we want it to float. © But today, we'll observe a different type of gas that will *not* allow our balloons to float, but will be equally fun.
