Please be sure to ask your child to see work returned to them. For tests or quizzes with grades below a certain score, scholars are given an opportunity to fix answers and return. Return by dates are written on the initial copy and a clean copy is attached. THESE DATES ARE HARD DEADLINES. If returned after the date (with the exception of begin absent on that date), they will not be accepted. DAILY ASSIGNMENTS do not have the option to fix to be regraded. Of course, feel free to have your scholar fix any mistakes for their own benefit because that is how we learn.

Be sure to check FACTS for any MISSING WORK. These assignments are indicated by an **M. P** is the code for an assignment turn in but waiting to be graded and updated. **LAST DAY FOR MISSING WORK TO BE RETURNED IS WEDNESDAY, MAY 13.**

Nightly practice of Latin Vocabulary and Multiplication facts is now becoming summer practice as well! It is necessary for scholar mastery of each subject. They will USE multiplication throughout the coming years in Math AND WILL REQUIRE A SOLID, WORKING KNOWLEDGE OF MULTIPLICATION so this needs to be automatic. WITHOUT A SOLID, WORKING KNOWLEDGE OF MULTIPLICATION, math assignments will start to take much longer than necessary to complete. Learning a new language, like Latin, takes constant practice as well. AGAIN, without the solid, working knowledge of LATIN, future time spent on assignments will be unnecessarily long.
