



OUTDOOR LEARNING

- We read *Charlie Needs a Cloak* and discussed the process of sheep to sweater: shearing, sorting, cleaning, carding, spinning, and then weaving or sewing. Because of the extreme cold on Tuesday, we stayed inside and watched a brief video of this process, then got to hold a real sheepskin rug. We wrapped it around ourselves to feel how thick and warm sheep's wool is. Comfy-cozy!



SCIENCE

- What is surface tension? Using dish soap and pepper, we'll see how soap breaks the surface tension of water, forcing the pepper to the sides of the dish. Pepper is hydrophobic – it is *not* attracted to water. It floats and does not melt or dissolve in water. The soap breaks the surface tension of the water and pushes the pepper away. Some have used this experiment as an object lesson, showing how our sins (the black pepper) are pushed away by Jesus' dying on the cross (the soap). Jesus removes our sins and purifies our hearts.
