Dear Parents,

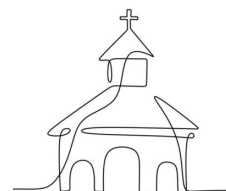
Below are some questions that your child will be able to discuss based on this and next week's lessons:
