Welcome back. We hope everyone had a restful Thanksgiving break.

This week in Latin, we began learning a new noun declension (second declension masculine nouns). For the quiz on December 12, the scholars will need to know the new vocabulary words and the Latin saying. They will also be expected to decline the noun *servus*. In history, we learned about the Sui and Tang Dynasties of China and about Mohammed and the beginning of Islam. The test on the four regions of the United States we have studied will be on December 18. We are still reading Farmer Boy. The quiz on Chapters 11-20 is scheduled for December 12. In religion, we read more about King Saul and David. We will have an English test next Thursday, December 11. The test will include classifying sentences and subject-verb agreement. We will have a math test on Unit II on December 18.
