MOORE NEWS

We are beginning Math Lesson 10 where we
learn how to divide fractions. We will be using the
Rule of 4, as we have been for adding &
subtracting. THIS WILL NOT LOOK LIKE THE WAY

YOU LEARNED IT. This method helps the scholar better understand WHY the method you learned works. Please be patient-we will get to the method you learned, DON'T show them a "short-cut."

Academic workload is increasing now that we have spent time reviewing material. Be sure to keep up through this newsletter, your scholar's assignment planner, and FACTS.

Also, please be asking your child to see work returned to them. Usually, work is returned on Fridays. However, I will return tests during the week so that if a test needs to be revisited for mastery-because the score is below 85-there is time to review before retaking. We go through the answers together as a way for all of us to review concepts. I also write on the test the scheduled date of the retest.

Speaking of writing notes on tests/quizzes, remember any tests (not Math, English, or Latin) or quizzes with grades below 70, will be given an opportunity to fix answers and return. Return by dates are written on the initial copy and a clean copy is attached. Don't let your child miss out! I would love to see more 5th grade scholars receive Honor Roll recognition for 3rd Quarter!

LIBRARY VOLUNTEERS!! If you can help in the library for our class, please let me know. We go every other week, normally from 12:20-12:50 on Tuesdays.

Some things don't change because the calendar flips, like uniform policies. Be sure your scholar is in proper dress code. Don't remember it? **Check the handbook for the regular & cold weather policies and options for uniforms!**

Healthy scholars experience better academic success! Please encourage your scholar to stay healthy by helping them to make **healthy choices**, like choosing **healthy snacks (not candy)**, washing hands, and covering coughs. Absences make learning more difficult since much of our material is presented orally.

Nightly practice of Latin Vocabulary and Multiplication facts is necessary for scholar mastery of each subject. We USE multiplication throughout our year in Math, so this needs to be automatic. Learning a new language takes constant practice.
