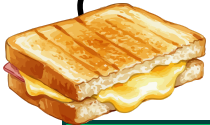

## ~ Third Form Latin 7B ~

### What we're still learning

- ~ We are still working with the perfect passive tenses
- ~ We are learning how to recognize a verb in the perfect passive tense, and from that, determine what the subject is as we translate sentences from Latin to English
- ~ We are also continuing to recognize when an ablative of agent or ablative of means is used in a sentence; the ablative of agent will always begin with the preposition a/ab followed by a noun in the ablative case; the ablative of means does not use a/ab and must be recognized only by the use of the ablative case

### What we're learning...

- ~ We continue to practice with prepositions that take, or govern, either the accusative or ablative case.
- ~ Generally, prepositions which express "motion toward" take the accusative case, while prepositions that express "location, no motion, or motion from" take the ablative case
- ~ Two prepositions, in & sub, can take either case and translate slightly different with each case.
