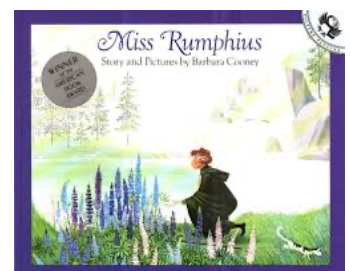


LETTERS & NUMBERS
