LETTERS & NUMBERS

- Cc – Letter box and song book. Tracing on dry erase pockets. Sky-writing.
- Introduced 2 – Song book. Discuss things related to two: things that come in pairs – socks, gloves, ice skates; twins; peanut butter and jelly, macaroni and cheese, salt and pepper, etc.

OUTDOOR LEARNING (Tuesday afternoon)

- We discussed things found in nature that are yellow – sunshine, flowers, bees, rainbows have yellow, etc. We went on a yellow hunt outside. We stopped by the art classroom to ask Mrs.

Leamon and the 4th graders for other things found in nature that are yellow. How many shades of yellow are there? Why does God use yellow for some things and darker colors for others?

SCIENCE (Thursday)

- *Let's go bananas!* You can see a message written on a banana because scraping the banana's skin damages its cells, **releasing an enzyme called polyphenol oxidase**. (We can see the same browning process in apples, avocados, and mangos, for example.) This **enzyme reacts with oxygen, triggering a chemical process that causes the damaged areas to turn brown**, making the message appear after a short time.
