much as possible to be prepared for the next level of education. These next **2 weeks** go very swiftly and activities increase! We all want your child to be fully prepared for next year!

Academic workload has increased in amount and difficulty. Be sure to read through this newsletter, your scholar's assignment planner (please ask to see this as an added emphasis to its importance-next year it will be invaluable!), and FACTS so that you can continue to support your scholar at home. If there is a disparity, your child's planner should be the most accurate, as we write what we actually accomplished in class. **STRESS TO YOUR SCHOLAR THE IMPORTANCE OF WRITING ASSIGNMENTS IN THE PLANNER THEY ARE GIFTED.** This is the best communication tool (scholar to self and supporting adults) we have.

Also, please be asking your child to see work returned to them. Work WAS returned YESTERDAY EVEN THOUGH IT WAS FIELD DAY! For tests (not Math, English, or Latin) or quizzes with grades below 70, scholars are given an opportunity to fix answers and return. Return by dates are written on the initial copy and a clean copy is attached. DAILY ASSIGNMENTS do not have the option to be regraded. Of course, feel free to have your scholar fix any mistakes for their own benefit because that is how we learn.

Healthy scholars experience better academic success! Please help your child make **healthy choices**, like choosing **healthy snacks (not candy)**, washing hands, covering coughs, and getting a proper night's sleep. Absences make learning more difficult since much of our material is presented orally.

Nightly practice of Latin Vocabulary and Multiplication facts is necessary for scholar mastery of each subject. We USE multiplication throughout our year in Math. WE HAVE NOW REACHED CONCEPTS THAT REQUIRES A SOLID, WORKING KNOWLEDGE OF MULTPLICATION so this needs to be automatic. Learning a new language, like Latin, takes constant practice as well.

SCHOOL REMINDERS

The Need for Speed should NOT be used through the neighborhood. Please be good examples of Love and Respect as you and your

scholars come in through the back gate during our construction time. We thank you, as we thank them, for your patience and attention.
