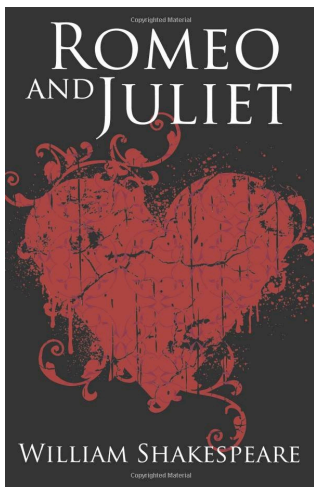

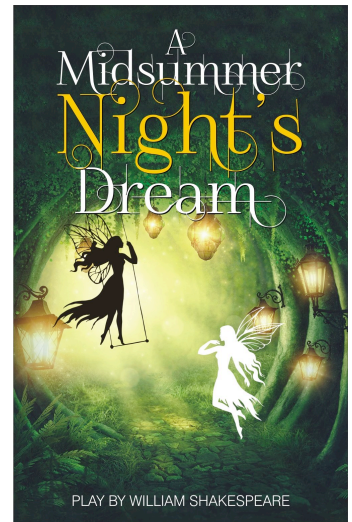

Seventh & Eighth Literature

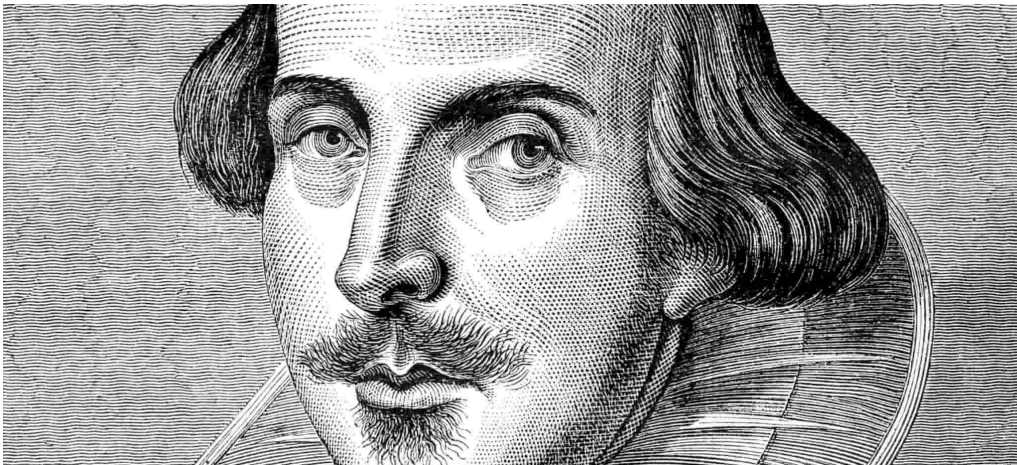


The Seventh and Eighth graders are going to perform their versions of the Shakespeare plays we read in class.

Logic I Monday 10/27- Third Act of the Mind: Reasoning Quiz

In Chapter 10, the Seventh Graders discussed the Third Act of the Mind- Deductive Inferences and their verbal expression- Syllogisms. Reasoning is the act by which the mind acquires new knowledge by means of what it already knows. A Syllogism is a group of propositions in orderly sequence, one of which (the consequent) is said to be necessarily inferred from the others (the antecedent). Deductive Inference is the act by which the mind establishes a connection between antecedent and the consequent.

There are three Terms in a Syllogism:

Major Term- The predicate of the Conclusion

Minor Term- The subject of the Conclusion

Middle Term- The term that appears in both Premises, but not in the Conclusion

There are two premises in the syllogisms antecedent:

Major Premise- The premise which contains the Major Term

Minor Premise- The premise which contains the Minor Term

Logic II

Monday 10/27- Polysyllogism & Sorites Quiz

Polysyllogism- A syllogism that links together several syllogisms in such a way that the conclusion of one serves as a premise for the next one.

All A are B.

All C are A.

Therefore, all C are B.

All D are C.

Therefore, all D are B.

Sorites- A chain argument which, through a chain of premises, connects the subject of the first premise with the predicate of the conclusion.

All A are B.

All B are C.

All C are D.

All D are E.
