We have finished Lesson 3 this week in Latin. We will begin Lesson 4 next week and will continue to work on 1st declension feminine nouns. For the quiz on October 9, the scholars will need to know their vocabulary words, the case endings, and the names of the different cases. In literature, we began reading <u>Farmer Boy</u>. In math, we worked on multiplying by 5. Next week, we will work on finding the area of rectangles and squares. This week, we read about St. Valentine and Diocletian in history. In religion, we read about Joseph's time in Egypt.
