Math Homework:

Subtraction Flashcards (-9 and -8) *and Doubles* (20-10=10; 18-9=9; 16-8=8, etc) and making 10s (10-9=1 and 10-1=9; 10-2=8 and 10-8=2 - corresponds to the making 10s addition lesson) Continue -9 and -8 and subtracting doubles flashcards as needed

Subtraction Concepts: Adding "backwards" to find the answer and fact families are some ways you can talk about math subtraction facts!

Reading Homework: Read **Ruby and Baby** page; Red Words: only, herself, danger, about, friend, wait, knew
