OUTDOOR LEARNING (Tuesday afternoon)

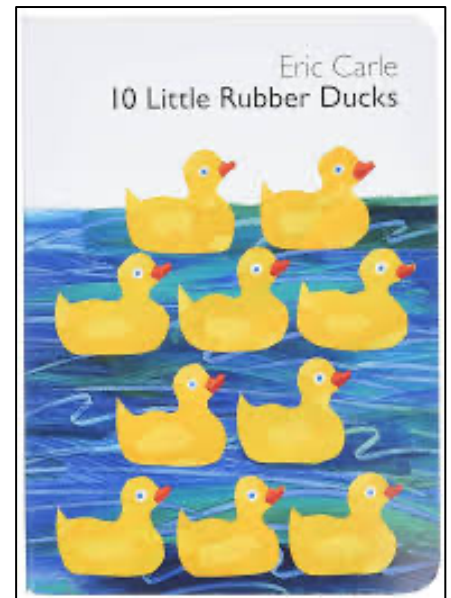
- We used prisms to make rainbows. Try to make rainbows on the ground, on exterior walls, on each other. How do the colors change? Which is easiest/hardest? A rainbow forms when sunlight interacts with raindrops in the atmosphere, causing refraction (bending), dispersion (spreading of colors), and reflection. Sunlight, a combination of all colors, enters a raindrop, bends, reflects off

the back of the drop, and then bends again as it exits, separating the light into its constituent colors to create the visible arc of the rainbow.

SCIENCE (Thursday)

- *Candy rainbows.* What will happen to the Skittles when we add water? Candy is full of dye (usually), which means the combination of dye and sugar dissolves quickly in water. When placed in a shallow pan of water, the **dye quickly dissolves** and starts to absorb into the water, making a colorful rainbow.
