Academic workload is increasing in amount and difficulty. Be sure to read through this newsletter, your scholar's assignment planner, and FACTS so that you can continue to support your scholar at home.

Also, please be asking your child to see work returned to them. Usually, work is returned on Fridays. However, I do return tests during the week so that if a test needs to be revisited for mastery-because the score is below 85-there is time to review before retaking. We go through the answers together as a way for all of us to review concepts. I also write on the test the scheduled date of the retest.

Speaking of writing notes on tests/quizzes, remember any tests (not Math, English, or Latin) or quizzes with grades below 70, will be given an opportunity to fix answers and return. Return by dates are written on the initial copy and a clean copy is attached. Don't let your child miss out! I would love to see more 5<sup>th</sup> grade scholars receive Honor Roll recognition for 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter!

LIBRARY VOLUNTEERS!! If you can help in the library for our class, please let me know. We go every other week, normally from 12:20-12:50 on Tuesdays.

**Healthy scholars** experience better academic success! Please encourage your scholar to stay healthy by helping them to make **healthy choices**, like choosing **healthy snacks (not candy)**, washing hands, covering coughs, and getting a proper night's sleep. Absences make learning more difficult since much of our material is presented orally.
