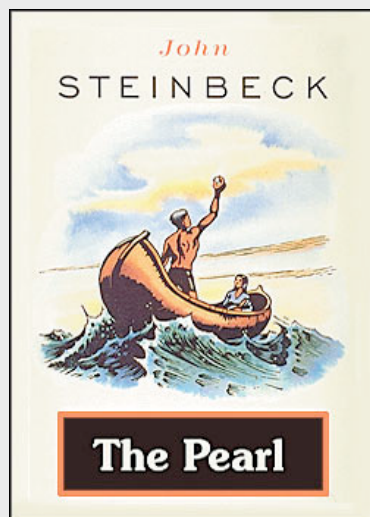

The Pearl by John Steinbeck.

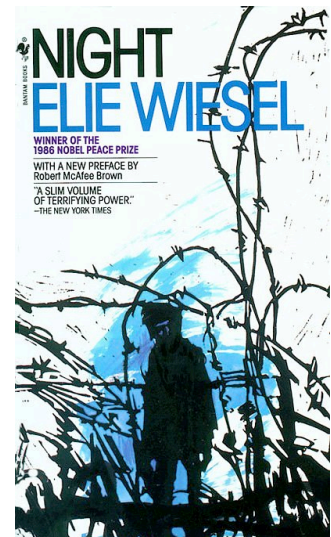

Oratio Eloquentium

The Our Savior Logic School scholars have started the Oratio classroom rounds. The first round will be presented to their respective classes and judged by their classmates and teacher. In addition to the presentation for competition, the selection will be a required English grade. The scholar's peer's scores will count for 40% of the presenter's score. The teacher's score will make up the remaining 60%. Scholars will be given two practice opportunities in class; one with a note card, and one memorized. The final classroom presentation will be the graded presentation. The scholars are responsible for remembering their presentation dates. Those dates are posted in the classroom.

The presenters will be judged on memorization, physical demeanor, delivery, and the difficulty of the selection chosen.
