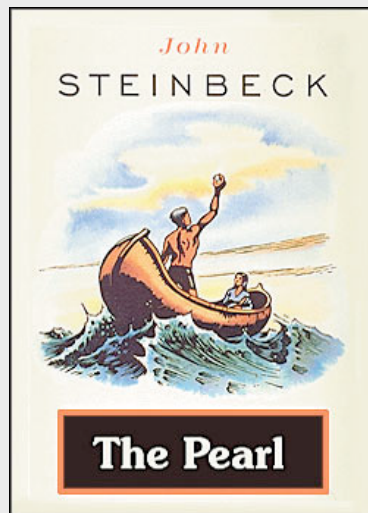

*The Pearl* by John Steinbeck.

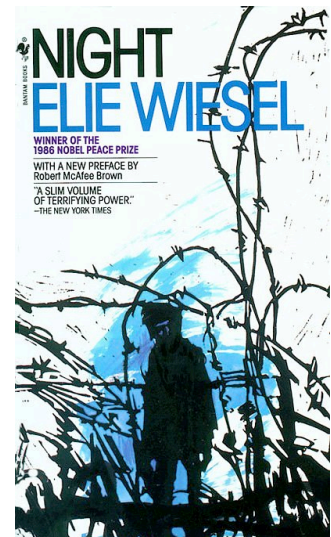

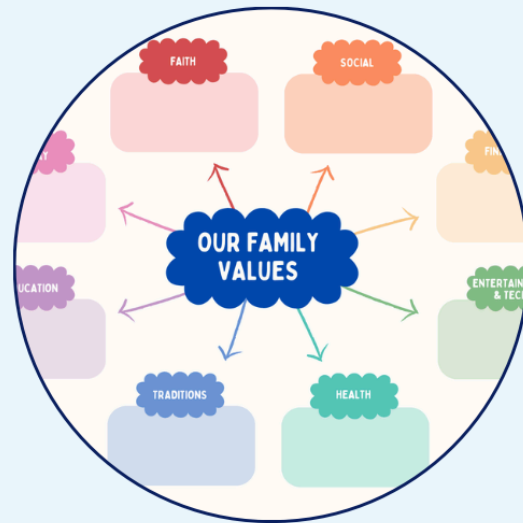

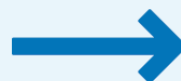
