They repeat the steps until they run out of numbers to bring down. Lesson 21 is on rounding numbers and estimating division answers. There will be a test on Friday, April 15.

Latin- We will begin lesson 18 on adjectives. There will be a test on Thursday, April 25.

Science- We are going to start our study of the order Hymenoptera. This is the order that includes wasps, bees and ants. We will be on this probably till the middle of May.
