"Speak, for Your Servant is Listening"

1 Samuel 3:10

From this passage, we see 3 things we can learn and apply to our lives as servants of our Awesome and Holy God:

1. Tune In and Listen

- *"Be still, and know that I am God! I will be honored by every nation. I will be honored throughout the world." — Psalm 46:10 [NLT]*
- We need to intentionally silence the busy world around us to anchor our focus entirely on Him.

2. Yield as a Humble Servant

- *"Then I heard the Lord asking, 'Whom should I send as a messenger to this people? Who will go for us?' I said, 'Here I am. Send me.'" — Isaiah 6:8 [NLT]*
- May we surrender our personal agenda to God's absolute authority and move immediately when He calls.

3. Move From Listening to Loving

- *"In the same way, let your good deeds shine out for all to see, so that everyone will praise your heavenly Father." — Matthew 5:16 [NLT]*
- Let us transform the truths we hear in private into active, visible, and loving service for the people around us.

Hearing God is never just about receiving information; it is about transformation. An attentive servant does not merely listen to the words of our Great and Awesome God, but captures His heart. When we practice being *"quick to listen"* (**James 1:19**), we lean in closely to hear His whisper and are empowered to go out and boldly show His love to a world in need. Listening is the quiet fuel of a lifetime of faithful, dynamic service.
