A Mother's Seed of Faith: "The Legacy of Eunice"

Eunice was a woman of quiet, steadfast devotion. Though she lived in a culture filled with many different beliefs, she remained anchored in her heritage of faith. Day after day, she didn't just tell her young son, Timothy, about God; she lived it out in the small moments—how she spoke to their neighbors, how she handled hardship, and how she prayed night and day.

As Timothy grew, he eventually left home to travel and serve alongside the Apostle Paul. Years later, while Timothy was far away and facing heavy responsibilities, he received a letter that reminded him of home. Paul wrote to him, not of his own accomplishments, but of the sincere faith that first lived in his mother, Eunice.

Eunice never preached to large crowds or traveled the world. Her ministry happened at her own kitchen table and in her own backyard. Yet, by being faithful in her "small" calling, she prepared her son to be a leader who would change the world. Her legacy wasn't found in what she did for herself, but in the unfading beauty of the faith she passed on.
