God's Memorial Day

When we don't remember the past, our present is susceptible to changing. In Scripture are examples of action taken to remember the past. Sometimes people set up a *memorial pillar* (Genesis 28:22). Sometimes people would have a *memorial service* such as when Joseph's father died (Genesis 50:10).

The yearly Passover was an enormous history lesson that was remembered each year. The past events were recited and even the food on the Passover table reminded the celebrant of events and feelings of their national past.

Just before He died, Jesus had the Passover with His Twelve, so we know where their minds were. While they were still at the table, Jesus took two food items from the Passover table and said, "Do this in remembrance of **Me.**"

Over time, the early church that came into existence remembered Jesus weekly in the Lord's Supper (Acts 20:7). Our minds must go back to His voluntary death on the cross so our sins could be paid for.

Our nation is right in setting aside a day to remember our fallen heroes. Some people visit cemeteries and memorials.

We are right to remember the enormous sacrifice of Jesus on our behalf each Lord's Day. Every Sunday is God's special Memorial Day.
