Being Thankful in all Circumstances

Being thankful all the time, is considered God's will for those in Christ Jesus. This principle is most clearly stated in **1 Thessalonians 5:16-18**, which says to be thankful in all circumstances.

- **A command from scripture:** These verses directly state that Christians should at all times be joyful, to never stop praying and to be thankful in every kind of circumstance. And it is clearly stated that this is what God wants. It is His will for our lives.

"Always be joyful. Never stop praying. Be thankful in all circumstances, for this is God's will for you who belong to Christ Jesus". – 1 Thes. 5:16-18 [NLT]

- **An action in prayer:** The Apostle Paul demonstrates this in **Philippians 4:6-7** by advising that instead of being anxious, Christians should approach God with prayer and thanksgiving.

"Don't worry about anything; instead, pray about everything. Tell God what you need, and thank him for all he has done. Then you will experience God's peace, which exceeds anything we can understand. His peace will guard your hearts and minds as you live in Christ Jesus."

- **A way to worship:** Being thankful is a way to worship God acceptably, as seen in **Hebrews 12:28**, *"Since we are receiving a Kingdom that is unshakable, let us be thankful and please God by worshiping him with holy fear and awe."*
