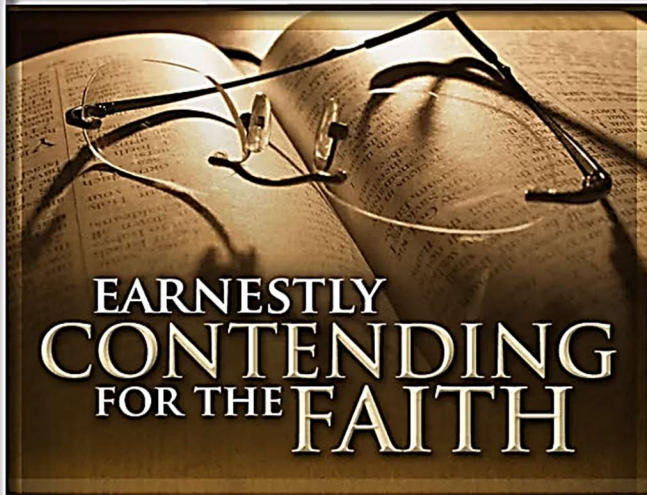

# Help the Schuler Family Rebuild After the Upriver Fire

Jon and Adriane had been in their home for seven years and raised their boys there. Jon's a part-time pastor, and the two of them are usually the ones helping somebody else through a rough stretch — dropping off a meal, showing up, praying with people. Being on the receiving end is new for them, and honestly, a little hard to accept.



They got out with their cars and a small camper trailer, a Ziploc bag of birth certificates and passports, a few laptops, the clothes they had on and their very confused dog, Nana. That was it. Everything else is gone.

Thankfully, they have good insurance, and they're grateful for it. The house will get rebuilt eventually. But "eventually" is a long road, and there's a lot of living to do between now and then. Right now the family is in a hotel and searching for a large rental home to lease nearby, so the boys can stay close to school, friends, and everything familiar while they wait out the rebuild.

The family is extremely grateful for the support they have already received, and yet so many more have asked how they can help that we set this up as a simple place to do it. **Whatever you give goes straight to the Schulers** — getting them into a rental that fits all five of them (with 3 growing boys!), replacing the everyday things you don't think about until they're gone, and buying Jon and Adriane some breathing room while they try to make sense of the hardest day of their lives. And if giving isn't where you're at, sharing this page or sending them a note of encouragement means every bit as much.

Thank you for loving this family well, as they have done for so many of us.
