“Loving One Another”

Loving one another as God has taught us is the very heart of the greatest commandments: to love God and to love our neighbor. This means showing grace, patience, and sacrificial service to those around us, reflecting the unconditional, boundary-breaking love Christ demonstrated for us.

Living out this kind of love in our daily routines often looks like:

Forgiving freely: Choosing to extend grace when others wrong us, just as we have been forgiven.

- *"Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you." - Ephesians 4:32*
- *"Bear with each other and forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against someone. Forgive as the Lord forgave you." - Colossians 3:13*

Serving sacrificially: Putting the needs of others before our own.

- *"My command is this: Love each other as I have loved you. Greater love has no one than this: to lay down one's life for one's friends." - John 15:12-13*
- *"You, my brothers and sisters, were called to be free. But do not use your freedom to indulge the flesh; rather, serve one another humbly in love." - Galatians 5:13*

Showing compassion: Showing kindness and being a "good neighbor" to those we encounter, including the vulnerable.

- *"Which of these three do you think was a neighbor to the man who fell into the hands of robbers?" The expert in the law replied, 'The one who had mercy on him.' Jesus told him, 'Go and do likewise.'" - Luke 10:36-37*
- *"If anyone has material possessions and sees a brother or sister in need but has no pity on them, how can the love of God be in that person?" - 1 John 3:17*
