God's Patient Mercy & Our Urgent Calling

(8) But do not let this one fact escape your notice, beloved, that with the Lord one day is like a thousand years, and a thousand years like one day. (9) The Lord is not slow about His promise, as some count slowness, but is patient toward you, not wishing for any to perish but for all to come to repentance. (10) But the day of the Lord will come like a thief, in which the heavens will pass away with a roar and the elements will be destroyed with intense heat, and the earth and its works will be burned up. – 1 Peter 3:8-10 [NASB]

This scripture encourages and reminds us that God's timing isn't as ours ("a day is like a thousand years") and His delay isn't slowness, but **mercy**—giving everyone time to repent. We should live with patient expectation, using this grace period to grow in godliness and share the Gospel, knowing the Lord's return is certain and will come unexpectedly, like a thief, bringing final judgment and change.

Peter has a lesson for us; that:

- 1. God's Time is Different:** Don't get discouraged by the apparent delay of Jesus' return; with God, time works differently (a day = a thousand years).
- 2. His Patience is Mercy:** The delay isn't carelessness; it's His loving desire for *everyone* to have a chance to turn to Him and be saved (repent).
- 3. We Must Live Ready:** Because the Day of the Lord *will* come suddenly and bring judgment, we must live today with holy living, faith, and readiness, not complacency.

God's patience gives us grace to live right and share hope, so let's not waste this precious time but live purposefully, awaiting His return with joy and faithfulness.
