Life's Mountains

Mastering life's mountains requires faith and action through these two key points: moving obstacles with faith and gaining strength through God's power.

1: Move Mountains with Faith

Truth: You do not need massive strength to beat big problems; you just need true faith in God. Even a tiny bit of trust in Him can do the impossible.

Scripture: *"You don't have enough faith," Jesus told them. "I tell you the truth, if you had faith even as small as a mustard seed, you could say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there,' and it would move. Nothing would be impossible."* — **Matthew 17:20 (NLT)**

2: Rise Above with God's Strength

Truth: When you feel weak and tired, God gives you new power so you can keep going and climb high without giving up.

Scripture: *"He gives power to the weak and strength to the powerless. Even youths will become weak and tired, and young men will fall in exhaustion. But those who trust in the Lord will find new strength. They will soar high on wings like eagles. They will run and not grow weary. They will walk and not faint."* — **Isaiah 40:29-31 (NLT)**

Prayer: "Heavenly Father, Thank You for being bigger than any obstacle, challenge, or mountain I face today. I confess that sometimes these problems look too big for me, but I know they are not too big for You. Please increase my faith. Even when it feels as small as a mustard seed, I choose to speak to my mountains and trust You to move them. I give You my worries, my fears, and the specific mountain I am climbing right now. I believe that You are already working it out for my good. Give me the courage to take bold action this week and live in the victory You have promised. In Jesus most powerful name, Amen.
