

## Our Worldwide Assignment

Today's 5-minute video is about **Tom and Debbie Morse** in Thailand. Tom is the second son of Eugene & Helen Morse. He primarily teaches at *Bethany Bible Training Center* along with several teachers who were formerly his students. Tom makes periodic trips to the remote tribal villages to encourage and train the many indigenous Lisu ministers who have been assigned to minister in the northern Thailand area.

Debbie home-schooled their seven children over the span of 25 years while involved in prayer and counseling ministries that she continues today.

**Jonathan Turner:** Jonathan specializes in Urdu-speaking people, both in Pakistan and in cities in the world where they have settled. An Urdu-speaking Muslim lady recently wrote for manuscripts of the regular broadcasts. This is remarkable as it is out of character for Muslim women.

Johnathan also teaches a church in Lahore using Zoom. He reports that nine have recently been baptized into Christ by his disciples there.

**Sam Gill:** This church supports Sam and Brittany Gill in Lahore monthly and Charles Dailey is a member of their board. They have just started to translate the primary work of theologian **Jack Cottrell** into Urdu. They have hired a professional translator to head the project. The book is "*The Faith Once For All.*" Dr. Cottrell does a top-notch job in arranging Scripture by subjects.

Lahore is a large city with about the same population as the populations of Oregon and Washington combined.
