DEFINITIONS (REVELATION 14:6-13)

- Torment: terrible physical or mental pain
- Wrath: extreme anger
- **Gospel**: the good news that Jesus died for us and saved us from our sin if we put our trust in him

QUESTIONS (REVELATION 14:6-13)

1. If someone asked you what the "good news" is, what would you say?

Humans are sinful people and our sin is what separates us from God, even after we die. There is nothing we can do on our own to change this.
