- 2. Does the patience of God mean that he overlooks or does not care about sin in his church?
- 3. Why is the gift of "the morning star" better than the gift of ruling nations with a rod of iron?
- 4. Read Luke 10:17-20. What is a better reason to rejoice than having power to cast out demons in Jesus' name?
- 5. How can each of us develop a heart that treasures our relationship to Christ and our identity in Christ as our deepest wellspring of joy?
