Kingdom Giving

Key Verse

Luke 6:38

Give, and it shall be given unto you; good measure, pressed down, and shaken together, and running over, shall men give into your bosom. For with the same measure that ye mete withal it shall be measured to you again.

2 Corinthians 8:5

And this they did, not as we hoped, but first gave their own selves to the Lord, and unto us by the will of God.

Kingdom Giving

- Giving is a requirement.
- Kingdom giving is the only giving that returns to the giver blessings in good measure, pressed down, shaken together, and running over (Luke 6:38).

Kingdom Giving: A Divine Principle

- Kingdom giving is deliberate, and purpose-driven;
- it is an act of total obedience to God.

Giving Is a Divine Privilege

- Giving is an opportunity.
- Giving is a true measurement of spirituality
- Read: John 1:3; Psalms 50:11-12

God's Custodians

- We, the people, are custodians of the material blessings, talents and abilities God has given us.

We Are Made to Give

- Kingdom giving will bring more to the giver than he will ever have room to contain.
- See Malachi 3:10.

Time to Intentionally Give

- Do not give your pearls to swine.
- Give your resources in obedience.
- Give because you love the Lord and His cause.
- Give your body as a living sacrifice to the Lord.

Time to Give Your Body

Romans 12:1 (KJV)

“I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service.”

Reasonable Service

Jesus needs:

- My hands to touch.
- My mouth to speak.
- My feet to go.

1 Corinthians 6:19-20

19 What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not [your own?]

20 For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God, in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.

Paul Encouraged a New Way of Thinking

Ephesians 4:17-20

17 This I say therefore, and testify in the Lord, that ye henceforth walk not as other Gentiles walk, in the vanity of their mind,

18 Having the understanding darkened, being alienated from the life of God through the ignorance that is in them, because of the blindness of their heart:

19 Who being past feeling have given themselves over unto lasciviousness, to work all uncleanness with greediness.

20 But ye have not so learned Christ”;

Lasciviousness

Lascivious behavior is sexual behavior or conduct that is considered crude and offensive, or contrary to local moral or other standards of appropriate behavior.

Grow in Giving

2 Corinthians 8:7

“But just as you excel in everything—in faith, in speech, in knowledge, in complete earnestness and in your love for us—see that you also excel in this grace of giving.”

Give Something Now!

- Prove God NOW by giving Him something that is of value to you.
- Give Him true worship.
- Give Him true praise.
- Give yourself totally to His service to the ministry He is calling you to do.
