Psalm 8:2- *Through the praise of children and infants you have established a stronghold against your enemies, to silence the foe and the avenger.*

2 Chronicles 20:12-18- ¹² *For we have no power to face this vast army that is attacking us. We do not know what to do, but our eyes are on you.”* ¹³ *All the men of Judah, with their wives and children and little ones, stood there before the Lord.* ¹⁴ *Then the Spirit of the Lord came on Jahaziel son of Zechariah, the son of Benaiah, the son of Jeiel, the son of Mattaniah, a Levite and descendant of Asaph, as he stood in the assembly.* ¹⁵ *He said: “Listen, King Jehoshaphat and all who live in Judah and Jerusalem! This is what the Lord says to you: ‘Do not be afraid or discouraged because of this vast army. For the battle is not yours, but God’s.* ¹⁶ *Tomorrow march down against them. They will be climbing up by the Pass of Ziz, and you will find them at the end of the gorge in the Desert of Jeruel.* ¹⁷ *You will not have to fight this battle. Take up your positions; stand firm and see the deliverance the Lord will give you, Judah and Jerusalem. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged. Go out to face them tomorrow, and the Lord will be with you.”* ¹⁸ *Jehoshaphat bowed down with his face to the ground, and all the people of Judah and Jerusalem fell down in worship before the Lord.*

Acts 16:22-25- ²² *The crowd joined in the attack against Paul and Silas, and the magistrates ordered them to be stripped and beaten with rods.* ²³ *After they had been severely flogged, they were thrown into prison, and the jailer was commanded to guard them carefully.* ²⁴ *When he received these orders, he put them in the inner cell and fastened their feet in the stocks.* ²⁵ *About midnight Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns to God, and the other prisoners were listening to them.* ²⁶ *Suddenly there was such a violent earthquake that the foundations of the prison were shaken. At once all the prison doors flew open, and everyone's chains came loose.*
