Matthew 15:1-2- Then some Pharisees and teachers of the law came to Jesus from Jerusalem and asked, <sup>2</sup> "Why do your disciples break the tradition of the elders? They don't wash their hands before they eat!"

**Observations** 

"From their (Pharisees) perspective Jesus was completely out of control because he disregarded their rules and crossed their boundaries." Theologian David Garland

Matthew 15:3-9- <sup>3</sup> Jesus replied, "And why do you break the command of God for the sake of your tradition? <sup>4</sup> For God said, 'Honor your father and mother' and 'Anyone who curses their father or mother is to be put to death.' <sup>5</sup> But you say that if anyone declares that what might have been used to help their father or mother is 'devoted to God,' <sup>6</sup> they are not to 'honor their father or mother' with it. Thus you nullify the word of God for the sake of your tradition. <sup>7</sup> You hypocrites! Isaiah was right when he prophesied about you: <sup>8</sup> "These people honor me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me. <sup>9</sup> They worship me in vain; their teachings are merely human rules."

Matthew 5:10-11- <sup>10</sup> Jesus called the crowd to him and said, "Listen and understand." What goes into someone's mouth does not defile them, but what comes out of their mouth, that is what defiles them."

Matthew 15:12- Then the disciples came to him and asked, "Do you know that the Pharisees were offended when they heard this?"

Matthew 15:13-20- <sup>13</sup> He replied, "Every plant that my heavenly Father has not planted will be pulled up by the roots. <sup>14</sup> Leave them; they are blind guides. If the blind lead the blind, both will fall into a pit." <sup>15</sup> Peter said, "Explain the parable to us." <sup>16</sup> "Are you still so dull?" Jesus asked them. <sup>17</sup> "Don't you see that whatever enters the mouth goes into the stomach and then out of the body?<sup>18</sup> But the things that come out of a person's mouth come from the heart, and these defile them.<sup>19</sup> For out of the heart come evil thoughts—murder, adultery, sexual immorality, theft, false testimony, slander.<sup>20</sup> These are what defile a person; but eating with unwashed hands does not defile them."

"The heart I am speaking of is that mysterious, wonderful, confusing part of you that enables you to love, laugh, fear, and experience life. It is the sphere in which relationship happens. And it is the sphere in which relationships are broken....The heart seeps into every conversation. It dictates every relationship. Our very lives emanate from the heart. We live, parent, lead, relate, romance, confront, react, respond, instruct, manage, problem solve, and love from the heart. Every arena of life intersects with what's going on in our hearts."

**Jeremiah 17:9-10 (MSG)-** "The heart is hopelessly dark and deceitful, a puzzle that no one can figure out. But I, God, search the heart and examine the mind. I get to the heart of the human. I get to the root of things. I treat them as they really are, not as they pretend to be."

**Mark 7:20-23 (MSG)**- Jesus went on: "It's what comes out of a person that pollutes: obscenities, lusts, thefts, murders, adulteries, greed, depravity, deceptive dealings, carousing, mean looks, slander, arrogance, foolishness—all these are vomit from the heart. There is the source of your pollution."

**Romans 3:23-26 (MSG)-** Since we've compiled this long and sorry record as sinners (both us and them) and proved that we are utterly incapable of living the glorious lives God wills for us, God did it for us. Out of sheer generosity he put us in right standing with himself. A pure gift. He got us out of the mess we're in and restored us to where he always wanted us to be. And he did it by means of Jesus Christ. God sacrificed Jesus on the altar of the world to clear that world of sin. Having faith in him sets us in the clear. God decided on this course of action in full view of the public—to set the world in the clear with himself through the sacrifice of Jesus, finally taking care of the sins he had so patiently endured.
