II Kings 4-5 –22 September 2022 "But What Kind Of Faith?"

Introduction

*These books demonstrate that a king's allegiance to God's Law was the key to success & protection

*We've seen Elisha used on a national scale, but God cares for the individual

*Today Elisha is sent to individuals to grow their faith

*The call of God throughout His Word is to come to Him <u>in faith</u> believing Him to do great things

*Jer 33:3 – Call unto Me & I will...shew you great & mighty things

*We say, "I have faith", but of what quality is it and to what extent does it guide our life and decisions?

*Today, we continue to look at ministry of the Prophet Elisha & we'll consider the faith of those he encounters

*So we'll ask ourselves 4 questions help us analyze our own faith

#1: How much faith do I have? (Chap 4:1-7)

Read Chap 4:1

- 1. The 'sons of the prophets' weren't unmarried monks hiding in the mountains
- 2. Sons would work to pay off family debt

Read Vs 2

1. We are called upon to use what little we have, believing that God will supply more for tomorrow

Read Vs 3-6

- 1. By what measure of faith she collected vessels, was the measure of the blessing she received
- 2. Notice she had to experience this walk of faith, Elisha couldn't do it for her

Read Vs 7

- 1. She chose to come, obeyed in faith, and then lived that way!
- Rewards in eternity based on our faithfulness now
 a. Parables of the Talents & Read Rev 22:12

#2: Is my faith alive now or resting on yesterday?(Chap 4:8-31)

- Read Chap 4:8-11
 - 1. Hospitality on display even before she knew that he was anyone important from her heart

Read Vs 12-13

- 1. Notice her modesty to live simply
- 2. Read Phil 4:11-12 *Contentment is a choice not an attainment* (REPEAT)

Read Vs 14-17

- 1. Having no child is tragedy b/c
 - a. No hope of the Messiah thru their family
 - b. No one to care for her in her old age

Read Vs 18-20

- 1. Don't live by old miracles, but by today's faith
 - a. Abe was miraculously given Isaac, but still had his faith tested later about offering Isaac

Read Vs 21-23

1. Husband didn't have faith to believe God could impact his life...just his Sunday -stale

Read Vs 24-27

- 1. You will notice as the story unfolds that Gehazi is into religion, not relationship
- 2. Elisha clearly sees the personal relationship aspect of what God's doing for His people

Read Vs 28-31

- 1. So using the staff didn't work
- 2. She put her faith in man of God, not in a staff
 - a. There's relationship with people, not items
 - b. Hezekiah, nehushtan (it's a thing of naught)

#3: Is my faith prompting positive dynamic action? (Chap 4:32-44)

Read Chap 4:32-37

1. Every miracle of God is unique, no method

- 2. Notice her thankfulness in vs 37
- So her dynamic living faith led to this miracle
 & she's forever etched in Hebrews 11 for it

Read Vs 38-41

- 1. Notice in all these miracles, there's no going backwards (removing the poison cucumbers)
- 2. We need only to look to God to add the good and press forward
 - a. In the stew of life, we put many poisoned things into our minds/heart – move forward adding only the good meal of the Word of God
 - b. In church, stay concerned w/ adding good;God will separate the wheat from the tares later
 - c. God is light & has made us light to be added to the darkness of this world

Read Vs 42-44

- 1. Miraculous feeding of the 100 like Christ
- 2. Elisha was much like Christ in his miracles

#4: Is my faith pointing others to God's power & glory? (Chap 5:1-27)

Read Chap 5:1

- Leprosy is pic of sin, Lev 13 says if it goes below skin, it is leprosy, but temptation strikes all Read Vs 2-3
 - 1. Purifying effect of 1 believer in this situation!
 - a. Saw this w/ Jehoshaphat in chap 3
 - b. Saw this w/ believing spouse in I Cor 7

Read Vs 4-7

- 1. "Why are you coming to me?"
 - a. Child of God is able to provide answers
 - b. In Gen 41:15-16 Joseph says to Pharoah,
 'it's not me, but God will give you the answer'
 - c. In Dan 2:26-28 Daniel says, 'no man can do this, but there is a God in heaven that can'

Read Vs 8-9

- 1. Christians want the lost & dying world to know that the Lord has all the answers they need...
 - a. But do they have faith to believe it
 - b. Read Luk 4:27 & Matt 13:58

Read Vs 10-12

1. Takes faith, not just to believe that God has the answers, but that God's methods & timing is right

Read Vs 13-14

- 1. Faith isn't hard physically, it's hard spiritually
 - a. Oh how easy it is to be saved!
 - b. We struggle b/c we want to earn God's favor or show ourselves worthy to receive

Read Vs 15-16

- 1. Don't even give the appearance that God's grace and blessings are for sale or exchange
 - a. Read Gen 14:21-24 Make it known that we prosper b/c of God hand on us, not man's

b. Read Dan 5:16-17 – Make it clear that you expect nothing for doing the work of the Lord
c. Read Act 8:19-21 – Can't buy God's gifts
Read Vs 17-19

- 1. Naaman pledges to only worship the Lord
- 2. He also asks for understanding that he has to support the king's false worship
 - a. What a clear example of Elisha showing grace to a baby Christian
 - i. Naaman heart is in the right place but needs time to sort out the mess
 - b. Give a new believer time to grow & purify by the Holy Spirit, not by rule after rule

Read Vs 20-24

- 1. After salvation, some Christians are roped into legalism now that you're saved, you have to...
- 2. Gehazi had to lie to make this happen
- 3. Naaman's heart is pure and willing, but

Gehazi's heart is greedy for earthly gain

Read Vs 25

1. Another lie to maintain his religion efforts Read Vs 26-27

- 1. The desire to heap up riches in this life is the opposite of faith
 - a. There's a fear that you don't have enough for tomorrow
 - b. There's a desire to live for this life & not eternity
- Cleansing of leprosy is only found in the cross of Jesus Lev 14
