Ephesians 3 – 11 September 2022 "Entrusted To Reveal Jesus"

Introduction

- *Ephesians Outlined
 - *Chap 1-3 The Position of the Christian
 - *Chap 4-6 The Practice of the Christian
- *Our Position = Not a new job, but a new identity
- *Chap 1, we saw we are <u>chosen</u> to receive a great <u>inheritance</u> & be <u>empowered</u> for this life & the next *Chap 2:1-10 reveals that God saved us b/c He <u>loves</u> us & wants to show His <u>greatness</u> working <u>thru us</u> *Chap 2:11-22 identifies the joy of bring <u>both Jews & Gentiles into one</u> body under Jesus
- *Chap 3 we begin to transition to "how do we live in this new life" by looking at Paul's example
- *Chap 3 Paul talks about <u>his</u> specific mission for God's glory, but we can use it to dive into <u>our</u> mission
- *Today, here's 3 ways we're entrusted to reveal Jesus Christ in our life

#1: Be good stewards of God's Word ministering it to others (Vs 1-7)

Read Vs 1

- 1. Read Gal 2:20 Paul's dead to self & only lives to please the One who loves him
- 2. Read I Cor 9:19 He's the servant of Christ which means serving others the gospel of Jesus
- 3. Christians are devoting to serving others, not by chains, but by the freedom Christ has given us

Read Vs 2-4

- 1. "Dispensation" is stewardship we've each been given a part of God's work to *govern* over
- 2. A mystery Paul was specifically given to reveal was that the church is Israel & Gentiles together
 - a. Alluded to in Eph 1:9, given in Eph 2:11-22
 - b. We too have the revealed mysteries of God's Word to give to lost people
 - i. Read I Cor 4:1-2 Called to be faithful in it
 - ii. Read I Pet 4:10 All are called to help others

Read Vs 5-6

- 1. Paul knew his specific calling to minister to the world...do we?
- 2. Read Rom 1:1 We're each just a servant but called to a specific task

Read Vs 7

- 1. The power to work and to use what's God's given us comes from the Holy Spirit Himself
- 2. Principle or Laws
 - a. Jesus didn't say, "Go try following all Laws"
 - b. He said, "I will put My laws into their hearts & in their minds will I write them"
- 3. Fishers of Men
 - a. Jesus didn't say, "Now go be fishers of men"
 - b. He said, "Follow Me & I will make you fishers of men"

#2: Boldly enter & embrace your eternal purpose (Vs 8-15)

Read Vs 8

- 1. When we recognize God's riches He's made available to us, it should humble us (G.R.A.C.E.)
- 2. It's humbling that we get to be on God's team doing work on His behalf

Read Vs 9

- 1. We get the joy of interchanging God's truths with the world & seeing some embrace it
- 2. "Created all things by Jesus Christ" Center of all is Jesus (creation to redemption to glorification)
 - a. Psm 33:6 By the Word of the Lord were the heavens made
 - b. John 1:14 Jesus is the Word of the Lord
 - c. Elohim Plural God that created (Gen 1:1)

Read Vs 10

1. Seems to be degrees of power in heaven in the angelic realm (principalities – *arche* or archangel)

- 2. God's wisdom & awesome plan is seen in how He's bringing salvation to mankind
- 3. I Pet 1:12 the angels are fascinated with how God's using His H.S. in the church today

Read Vs 11-12

- 1. Christ's actions brought us access to God
- 2. Life seems so hap-hazard at time, in a confusing whirlwind, but God has a purpose for it all
 - a. Read Heb 4:14-16 Jesus has cut the way for us to come & receive the help we need
 - b. Jew or Gentiles, whatever background; by faith in Jesus, we come & receive grace & hope

Read Vs 13-15

- 1. Paul isn't concerned that he has troubles in bringing them the Gospel...it's worth it
 - a. Knows he can get help from God when needed
 - b. With all the prejudice out there, Paul reminds them that ALL PEOPLE are worth bringing to God

#3: Encourage others to burst out-loud b/c of God's great love (Vs 16-21)

Read Vs 16

- 1. The place we need to be empowered the most is our Spiritual life
- 2. Ask this of the Lord for each other

Read Vs 17

- 1. This is deeper than having knowledge of Jesus
- 2. That Jesus may be on the throne of your heart
 - a. Is He the master passion driving you?
 - b. Have you been established unmovable in your love for Him just as He loves you?

Read Vs 18

- 1. Comprehend what? How much love He has
- 2. This's physically impossible, notice it's 4-D
- 3. Comprehending God's love for us is spiritual

- 4. David Guzik said, "God's love is...
 - a. Wide enough to include every person
 - b. Long enough to last for eternity
 - c. Deep enough to reach the worst sinner
 - d. And high enough to take us to heaven!"

Read Vs 19

- 1. To be filled with all of God can't happen, but we're on a journey in that direction
- 2. Love of Christ passes knowledge in that...
 - a. It's better than any other knowledge
 - b. It defies logic that God would love sinners

Read Vs 20-21

- 1. God is able to do big things, so ask for big things that will bring Him praise
- 2. The essential goal of the church is to bring God praise for His great love wherewith He loves us

1. Be good stewards of God's Word, ministering it to others

- a. We have the life-giving mysteries of God
- b. Let the power of the H.S. lead you

2. Boldly enter & embrace our eternal purpose

- a. Regardless of hazards, Jesus is worth serving
 - o. What shall it profit to gain world & lose soul

3. Encourage others to burst out-loud b/c of God's great love for them

- a. Talk of God's love & grace, see it, believe it
- b. God's love is the motivation needed to be born again into new life and then live there
