Daniel 3 –26 June 2025 "Burning To Shine His Glory"

Introduction

*Book's Theme: "God's power to bring Israel thru the kingdoms of this world to exaltation"

*Book's Outline: 2 halves (historical chronology chap

1-6 & a is more detailed prophetic visions chap 7-12)

*Chap 1 – Believer in an unbelieving world

*Chap 2 – All world empires ended by the Kingdom

*Chap 3 – Believer raptured while Israel goes thru the Tribulation

*Chap 4 – King of Babylon as Satan is bound

*Chap 5 – Earth's ruler gathers for a last battle but is overthrow

*Chap 6 – New world-ruling kingdom w/ unchanging laws is established

*Dan 3 gives us a classic example of living real faith! *Heb 11:6 tells us *w/o faith it's impossible to please God* – He rewards those that live for Him by faith

Today, we'll see the actions of 3 distinct parties during a real test of faith

#1 – We'll see the Cowering of the Coerced Crowd (Vs 1-7)

Read Vs 1

- 1. Seems this is in direct rebellion to the dream Nebu had in chap 2 just a short time before
 - a. That had a head of gold for Babylon & further kingdoms after Babylon w/ other metals
 - b. This is <u>completely</u> of gold symbolizing Nebu believes his reign will never end

Read Vs 2-3

- 1. Calling all the micro-leaders shows this is intended to be a loyalty test
- a. This foreshadows the Anit-Christ requiring his mark to buy or sell as a loyalty test to him
 2. Remember, in chap 2 Daniel was promoted to prefect w/ the 3 others, yet he's not listed as here
 a. His absence is 100% mysterious, on purpose
 b. Daniel is a picture of rapture before the Trib

Read Vs 4-6

1. Death by fire seems to be Nebu preferred death penalty b/c this is also recorded in Jer 29:22

- 2. So this loyalty test isn't just limited to politics; this also asks for your <u>religious</u> loyalty
 - a. Now, we <u>can</u> offer allegiance to our country thru the flag, & this doesn't bleed over to our religious allegiance
- 3. We obey our political rulers until we're asked to disobey God *that* is a time to stand!

Read Vs 7

- 1. Would we follow the crowd all around us?
- 2. Look at the circumstances
 - a. It was beautiful with music and fanfare
 - b. Nearly all your friends around are doing it
 - c. Your life is literally on the line
- 3. How many in this crowd made excuses?
 - a. "I'm not <u>really</u> worshipping; I'm just going along to get alone"
 - b. "The good Lord knows my heart"
- 4. What we often fail to remember is that when situations are forced on us, these are the chances to return the greatest glory to God
 - a. We just saw this in chapter 1

#2 – We'll see the Flex of the Faithful Few (Vs 8-18) Read Vs 8-12

- 1. These Chaldeans seem motived by jealousy from chap 2 & a lust to maintain their power
- 2. As for the 3 Jews; notice how they acted
 - a. They didn't cop out & worship the image
 - b. They also didn't publicly protest & make demand
 - c. They simply obeyed God w/ abstinence from evil & took it no further

Read Vs 13-15

- 1. It's good practice to ask questions & get the details & don't just assume we know the facts
 - a. Read Prov 18:13 Don't answer before you hear it
- 2. What god is there who can save from me?
 - As a prototype of the Anti-Christ to come, Nebu sees himself, not just as a man, but as the greatest god

- b. Can't Nebu remember what Daniel's God just did in chap 2?
- c. Pride will give you willful amnesia

Read Vs 16-18

- 1. Notice 3 things about their answer
 - a. It an unambiguously clear stand for Christ
 - b. It gives glory to God's ability, not their own
 - c. It isn't presumptuous of God's plan & will
- 2. What's the difference David knew he would take out Goliath & these 3 men didn't know?
 - a. David had God's revealed will; God already said that the land was theirs & not for others
 - b. These 3 men only had the general will ofGod, not to serve anything but God, they didn'thave God's specific will for how to do it
- 3. Faith is not in action when we can see the rope bridge ahead
 - a. But faith will act even when it can only feel the strands of rope or simply only the hear the strong call of God from the other side

#3 – We'll see the Guarantee of the Glorious God (Vs 19-29)

Read Vs 19-23

- 1. These details say the 3 men were completely at the mercy of God they had no earthly chance
- 2. THESE are times God can get the most glory
- 3. I believe they were remembering Isaiah's words at this time Read Isa 43:2

Read Vs 24-25

- 1. There is tradition that Nebu's attention was caught b/c he heard singing in the fire
 - a. Reminds us of Paul & Silas in jail
- 2. True worshippers know that when they have nothing on earth, they still have intimacy w/ God
- 3. There is nowhere we can go, or be sent, that the Lord cannot meet us there & meet our needs there
- 4. And when we're found in a trial by fire, whether by the devil or by man, we can know there's a sovereign God controlling it all

- 5. Notice they were *in* their circumstance yet didn't have to live *under* their circumstance b/c God was with them
- 6. And they're not even interested in leaving!a. They're just walking, enjoying God's glory

Read Vs 26-27

- 1. Everyone saw the glory of God, why?
 - a. B/c these men had enough faith to stand for God in the first place
- 2. This is complete deliverance, not even a smell
- 3. We've the same promise (Read John 16:33)

Read Vs 28

- 1. How did Nebu know that they trusted in God?
 - a. B/c they put their faith into action
- 2. People know what you believe by your actionsa. What are you showing them?

Read Vs 29-30

1. God brought prosperity to the 3 men b/c of their trust in Him

- 2. The ways of God lead to prosperity, even if you can't see how it could possibly come to pass
- 3. So what is the guarantee when we act in faith?
 - a. Peace w/ God (Read Rom 5:1)
 - b. Joy unspeakable (Read I Pet 1:8)
 - c. Eternal life (Read John 3:16)
 - d. These 3 men had it all

Conclusion

How do we act when 'the heat is on'? When chances, small and large arise to shine our faith in God...

- 1. Are we cowering like the coerced crowd?
- 2. Or do we flex like the faithful few
- 3. Have we experienced the guarantee of our

glorious God? – You will when you act in faith!

We have a great chance to shine brightly as the world around us gets darker and darker

Are we willing to endure the struggle to shine for Jesus Christ – He's worth it!
