Psalms 107-108 – 2 November 2025 "Then They Cried Out To The Lord"

Introduction

- *This is 1st of about 12 messages in the 5th & final Book of Psalms
- *Psalms the Israeli Hymnbook or Book of Praises
- *Many times when we're in trouble, we wonder where to get the answers we need
- *Well the only answer that's sufficient, is that when we find ourselves in need, we cry out to God
- *So today we'll see 6 reasons to cry out to the Lord

#1: When we're wandering: Let Him lead us in the straight path (Psm 107:1-9)

Read Psm 107:1

- 1. "Oh" = an exclamation point at the end!!!
- 2. "He is good" means there's nothing bad in Him
- 3. How do we know He's good?

- a. B/c we experience His mercy & love
- 4. We can trust it'll never cease to be toward us Read Vs 2-3
 - 1. Direct application seems to be Israel's regathering after Babylon
 - a. Also applicable in sense that we've been redeemed from all sin & returned to God
 - 2. "Let the redeemed say so"
 - a. I was in prison to my sin & God saved me
 - b. What a joy to speak of God's salvation
 - 3. If we're not speaking of it; there's a problem
 - a. Pride: We don't know how bad our sin was
 - b. We've never truly been forgiven

Read Vs 4-6a

- 1. We too wandered in the wilderness of sin
- 2. Just like the Prodigal Son account
 - a. Read Luke 15:16-17 He came to himself
 - b. Only when we see our helplessness do we see the solution that Christ Jesus offers

Read Vs 6b-9

- 1. Notice He leads us in a direct path to goodness
 - a. God's ways take us directly to fruitfulness
 - b. God's plan is for good only & can't harm
- 2. See, He satisfies our needs that sin never fulfilled
 - a. We desire friends, good purpose, true family; He fills up our needs fully
 - b. Knowing God's plan for our redemption is the only thing capable of bringing peace & rest

#2: When we're doing what is harmful: Let His Word light our path (Psm 107:10-16)

Read Psm 107:10-13a

- 1. Now this describes, not just wandering, but the place of receiving bad
 - a. They receive bad b/c of their sins
- 2. If we're sitting in darkness, it's b/c we've refused the Light of God's Word
 - a. Read Isa 59:2 & John 3:19-20

Read Vs 13b-16

- 1. When God saves, He saves to the uttermost
 - a. He didn't unlock our handcuffs of sin, He broke them
 - b. He didn't open the prison doors, He broke them
- 2. And now as I Pet 2:9 says, He calls us out of darkness & into His marvelous light
 - a. If you're still in your sin, you're sitting in sin's no door prison, handcuffs broken on the floor

#3: When we're living a foolish life: Let His Word heal us (Psm 107:17-22)

Read Psm 107:17-19a

- 1. Now we have those so dumb & foolish that they live with a corrupt lifestyle but can't even realize they're living in the pigpen
- 2. And yet, it's the same solution for this group of people as for any other group; cry out to God

Read Vs 19b-22

- 1. How does He lead us in a direct path to good?
 - a. He sends His Word, guidebook to goodness
- 2. Let's thank God for giving the Light of His Word

#4: When we're being tossed by troubles: Let His Word bring you to the haven (Psm 107:23-32)

Read Psm 107:23-28a

- 1. These are those being tossed up & down by this world's storms
 - a. Those engaged w/ & abused by trying to turn a dollar
 - b. The highs & lows of the stock market & all the rest leave us unsettled
- 2. "All their wisdom was swallowed up" b/c we often get to the place where we realize this world can destroy us if it wants to
 - a. Unless we... cry unto the Lord
 - b. In every situation, we can cry unto the Lord

Read Vs 28b-32

- 1. God commands the world system, even nature itself
- 2. The Lord knows how to deliver the just out of the world system (II Pet 2:9) just as He delivered Lot out of the worldly influence of Sodom

#5: B/c He can change any & all circumstances for those that ask (Psm 107:33-43)

Read Psm 107:33-38

- 1. Production of our environment & resources is completely under the hand & control of God
 - a. He multiplies loaves & fish to feed 1,000s
 - b. He can destroy great resources like He destroyed Israel's great army at Ai after Jericho
- 2. Our abilities, resources & plans are NOTHING without the blessing of God on them
 - a. Striving for <u>our will</u>, even w/ great resources can fail
 - b. Serving for <u>His will</u>, even w/ little resources will win

Read Vs 39-42

- 1. The Lord is a dividing God
 - a. There is no noble prince that He cannot bring down in their pride
 - b. There is no needy poor that He cannot lift up from their despair

Read Vs 43

- 1. What's it take to access this restoration & love?
 - a. Well vs 42 it's the upright, the righteous that will see it
 - b. It's those that cry unto God that'll receive it

#6: B/c it exalts the Lord & shows trust in His power (Psm 108)

Intro – This is a compilation of two of David's Psalms Vs 1-5 is Psalm 57:7-11 Vs 7-13 is Psalm 60:5-12

Read Vs 1-4

1. Is your heart fixed so that no circumstance can take you away from praising God?

- 2. Faith lifts us above the circumstances & let's God have His way in our heart & actions
 - a. We become unafraid to be seen for Jesus

Read Vs 5

- 1. This emphasizes what is set as a chorus to repeat
- 2. You can almost hear the Psalmist saying, nevertheless, not my will, but Your will be done

Read Vs 6

- 1. Now Lord, use your exalted power to deliver me Read Vs 7-9
 - 1. David prophetically speaks for God, seeing that God reigns over, not just the whole earth, but this land specifically that David's currently battling for
 - 2. God's using specific parts of Israel for specific missions
 - 3. God also sees <u>immediate surrounding nations</u> w/ contempt for the way they've treated Israel

Read Vs 10-13

- 1. Man can fail at any moment when he acts independent of God
- 2. "Vain is the help of man" If God is for us, there is no power that can stand against that
- 3. David turns to God after defeat & determines to get back in line behind his strong God

- 1. If you're wandering, let Him lead you in a straight path
- 2. If you're doing what's harmful, let His Word light your path
- 3. If you tend to be foolish, let His Word heal

- 5. If you need your situation changed, trust that God can do that for those that ask
- 6. In all circumstances, our trusting exalts God
