## I Kings 12=13 –11 August 2022 "Small Adjustments In Leadership"

## **Introduction**

- \*I & II Kings demonstrate that a king's allegiance to God's Law is the key to success & protection

  \*The 1<sup>st</sup> half of I Kings depicts the reign of Solomon

  \*The 2<sup>nd</sup> half of I Kings begins the divided kingdom
- \*Solomon just died Rehoboam his son is now King
- \*When there's been prosperity for a while & then change in leadership, challenges will arise
- \*In fact in today's record the kingdom will split in 2
- \*We're all leaders of something a home, a dog, a family, co-workers
- \*We're all called to be Christian leaders leading others to see the glorious nature of Jesus Christ
- \*Let's lead well we don't want to divide but help
- \*Today we'll see 4 minor adjustments that will enable us to S.A.I.L. thru leadership

## 1<sup>st</sup> adjustment – Staples: Take the old wise counsel, not the young bias counsel (Chap 12:1-24)

### Read Chap 12:1-5

1. Jeroboam wants relief for his tribe from the heavy work so he asks the new king Rehoboam

#### Read Vs 6-7

- 1. Old wise counsel is this: "the way up is the way down"
- 2. Read Mar 10:42-45 Be the biggest servant Read Vs 8-11
  - 1. Young men were bias still seeking positions in the kingdom and were still inexperienced
  - 2. They thought they had to squash some ungodly rebellion but the people's cause was just

### Read Vs 12-15

- 1. God didn't make him stupid, just withdrew help
- 2. When you don't seek the wisdom of God, all you're left with is the stupidity of man

#### Read Vs 16-20

- 1. So 10 tribes follow Jeroboam in the north and refuse to pay taxes to Rehoboam
- Rehoboam leaves his coronation and heads back to his capital Jerusalem

### Read Vs 21-24

- 1. They didn't seek God's Word regarding taxing, but at least Rehoboam listens when God's Word comes
- 2. There's no older, wiser voice than God's to hear

## 2<sup>nd</sup> adjustment – Attainment: Don't have to maintain what God has attained (Chap 12:25-33)

### Read Chap 12:25-27

- 1. Jeroboam thinks he has to maintain what God has freely given to him, wrong
- 2. When God guides, God provides

### Read Vs 28-30

1. Cause this worked out so well for Aaron, ha

- 2. Notice, he doesn't make a different god, he simply says that these calves are the REAL God
  - a. Many so-called Christians today are into this same idol worship similar but different
- 3. They give the REAL God very different attributes but claim that it is indeed Jehovah God
  - a. Mormons claim Jesus is lucifer's brother that's a different god
  - b. Many have gender & sexual issues all wrong that's believing in a different god

### Read Vs 31-33

- 1. Different but similar priests & feasts
- 2. Man-made 'maintaining' are counterfeits
  - a. These all are created in Jeroboam's own image, not God's
  - b. He's completely thrown out the Bible at this point
  - c. He's made a similar but different religion for himself that he's more comfortable with

## 3<sup>rd</sup> adjustment – Implement: Change course to follow God-given opportunities (Chap 13:1-10)

## Read Chap 13:1-5

- 1. Prophecy against corruption of the priesthood
  - a. Short-term proof is needed to validate the message of the prophet
    - i. Altar with be ripped up Short-term
    - ii. Future King Josiah will desecrate this false worship Long-term
- 2. Publicly disagreeing with God's prophet got King Jeroboam immediate punishment

### Read Vs 6

- 1. Ask your God to help my physical problem
  - a. If He was Jeroboam's God, he could ask for himself
  - b. If He was Jeroboam's God, he wouldn't ask for his hand, but his heart to be healed
  - c. He missed a good repentant spot

- 2. The Man of God besought the Lord
  - a. The measure of our Christianity isn't how with treat Jesus, but how we treat Judas
  - b. Read Luk 6:28, 32, 36 Love your enemies

### Read Vs 7-10

- 1. Read Eph 5:11 & II John 1:10
- 2. Don't give the perception that you agree with sinful people

# 4<sup>th</sup> adjustment – Liars: Don't let man deceive you off of God's course (Chap 13:11-34)

## Read Chap 13:11-17

- 1. Old Prophet of Bethel wants the Man of God to come eat with him, but Man of God was told by God not to eat with them on this mission
- 2. Old Prophet probably just wanted to help a very weary co-patriot prophet (under a oak tree)

#### Read Vs 18-19

- 1. Read Gal 1:8 & Deut 13:1-3
  - a. God can't contradict Himself, don't fall for it
  - b. He listened to man instead of God
- 2. There is greater accountability for those who speak for God James 3:1
  - a. The gifts of the Spirit co-exist within varying degrees of imperfection in the person

### Read Vs 20-24

1. The Old Prophet prophecies judgement to the Man of God from Judah for disobeying the Lord

### Read Vs 25-32

- 1. Old Prophet shows respect & buries him
- 2. Judge others in light of your own sin (Matt 7:2)
- 3. Old Prophet also shows that he believes the Man of God's prophecy about the false worship

### Read Vs 33-34

1. None of this changed Jeroboam from his sin

### Conclusion

There are many tiny forks in the road that we need to choose between right & wrong but also good & better

- 1. <u>Staples</u>: Take the old, wise counsel, not the young, bias counsel
  - a. The best old wise counsel is God's Word
- 2. <u>Attainment</u>: Don't have to maintain what God has attained for us
  - a. It takes work to maintain our own lies & self-effort, but following God's plan for our lives will be empowered to success
  - b. Where God guides, God provides
- 3. <u>Implement</u>: Change course to follow Godgiven opportunities
  - a. There're many micro-chances to repent
- 4. <u>Liars</u>: Don't let man deceive you off of God's course
  - a. Some w/ evil intent, some as simple distractions, but watch out for contradictory info that would remove you from God's plan
