# Jeremiah 9-10 – 6 June 2024 "The Temple Sermon Against Religion" Part 2 of 2

# **Introduction**

- \*Jeremiah consistently warned Judah to submit to Babylon for judgment, therefore he was treated as a traitor
- \*1st Section (Chap 1-6) we saw the reasons for Judah's fall & God's challenge to accept His guidance
- \*Last week we began 2<sup>nd</sup> Section: The Temple Sermon (Chap 7-8) Jeremiah goes to the gate of the Temple
- \*Jeremiah cries against their twisted religion
- \*Religion is simply man's efforts to please God

# Today we'll see final 3 elements of dead religion in the 2<sup>nd</sup> half of Jeremiah's Temple Sermon

- \*Just a recap of the 1st 3 elements from Chap 7-8
  - \*Religion is external, not from the heart
  - \*Religion adds layers, not purely what God wants
  - \*Religion is hopeless, not answering the spirit

# #4 – It's deadly, not lifegiving (Chap 9:1-26)

# Read Chap 9:1-2

1. Weeping Prophet weeps b/c of their wickedness

#### Read Vs 3-6

- 1. Important to remember that Judah wasn't tricked into sin, but it's willful
- 2. They used their tongue for lies & deceit instead of growing in their relationship with the Lord
  - a. The greatest cost to going your own way, is that you never come to know who God really is

### Read Vs 7-11

- 1. Destruction from their own hypocrisy
  - a. Speaking peace yet murdering them in heart
- 2. Broke all the Law; didn't love God or others

#### Read Vs 12-16

- 1. All this was told to them 800 years earlier
- 2. Your homework is Lev 26
  - a. The *reasons*, the *timing*, the *scattering* & the *restoration* are all talked about there

b. They are without excuse

#### Read Vs 17-22

- 1. There is a proper time to cry and mourn
  - a. Introspection is needed from time to time
- 2. Notice this is b/c they've 'forsaken the land'
  - a. This is prophesied as part of Lev 26
  - b. This is quoted in (Turn to) II Chr 36:19-21

# Read Chap 9:23-24

- 1. You want to get excited about something? You want to promote something? Promote that you know the life-giving God of the Universe!
- 2. Pride in self needs destroyed; pride in God needs exalted
- 3. What do you see as great value in your life?

## Read Vs 25-26

- 1. It's not about your *background or family*, it's not about your *religious knowledge* or lack of it
  - a. It's about the *condition of your heart*

# #5 – It's incapable, not effective to provide (Chap 10:1-18)

# Read Chap 10:1-3

- 1. The emphasis <u>is</u> to not follow after false religious practices of the world, emphasis <u>isn't</u> on the specific symbols that they're using
- 2. Don't allow false worship of astrology to dictate your life and direction
  - a. Don't need to look to stars for your answers, you can look to the very One who made those stars
- 3. We follow, in faith, the written Word of God
  - a. Evil & adulterous people that seeks a sign

### Read Vs 3-5

- 1. The emphasis here is on the energy man expends yet the idol still has no power
  - a. They stand up the tree like a scarecrow, but there's no life or power
  - b. It can't speak or stand & needs carried
    - i. Have wrong God! B/c our God carries us

- c. Can't do evil or good—completely incapable
- 2. Some compare this to having a Christmas tree
  - a. 1<sup>st</sup> principle (Read Rom 14:22-23) There are issues of changing Christian practice that we each needs to draw answers from God's Word
  - b.  $2^{nd}$  principle There are differences
    - i. Jeremiah's tree was an idol of worship, modern Christmas trees are not
    - ii. Jeremiah's time trees were their false gods, modern idols are cars, jobs, relationships & entertainment devices
- 3. If you leave here wondering if you can have a Christmas tree, you miss the point
  - a. Point? Beware of idols in <u>our</u> life preventing us from hearing God

### Read Vs 6-10

1. It not just that they have a habit or custom that's not helpful; it's that they're teaching that these idols have power to change your life – but they don't

- a. In all the world, that power belongs to God
- 2. Vs 10 God is the God of truth
  - a. There is a meaningfulness to God that can't be found in your idols today

#### Read Vs 11-16

- 1. Our God is in control & actively able to provide all that we need
- 2. It's only the unbelievers that see the sea waves and heavenly signs & get scared
  - a. Read Luke 21:25 They don't know what's coming
  - b. We trust our God & we're protected thru Him

# Read Vs 17-18

- 1. To sling them out, as in a slingshot
- 2. Babylon again being seen as an instrument of God's judgement on Judah

# #6 – It's a thief, not fulfilling (Chap 10:19-25)

# Read Chap 10:19-20

1. Judah is pictured as a desperate nomad bereft of his family for support

#### Read Vs 21-22

- 1. 'Brutish' is wasted or burned away
  - a. Since their shepherds haven't sought the Lord, they have nothing to offer the people
  - b. Must receive from God, to affect others
- 2. If living for vain idols, you have vanity to offer
- 3. If living for Jesus, you have life to offer others

#### Read Vs 23

1. Read Prov 3:5-6 – We're helpless without the light of God's Word and truth

## Read Vs 24-25

- 1. It's not wrong to expect God to judge those who refuse to know Him
- 2. What is not just is to ask God to be kind to us a. Beyond just; it's simply mercy & grace

# Conclusion

Still today, it's easy to fall into dead religion. What out for signs of it...

From 1<sup>st</sup> half of the Sermon

- 1. **It's external** it needs to be in your heart
- 2. **It adds layers** it can't be a *projection of my thoughts*, but it must be the *prescription of God's thoughts*
- 3. **It's hopeless** it needs to benefit our spirit Now from today, we can add..
  - 4. **It's deadly** If God is loving (& He is), He must put to death willful sin
  - 5. **It's incapable** it can't provide anything good into your life
  - 6. It a th ief it will leave you empty & destitute
