Acts 10:34-11:18 – 12 July 2020 "Who's Leading This Thing, Anyways?"

Introduction

Jesus has ordained there to be an "Age of the Church" <u>empowered by His HS</u> where He pours His attention toward THE WHOLE WORLD

Acts 8:1 – Persecution has scattered the church

In Acts 9:32 Peter began to go throughout the country.

It may seem very random where he goes, but it's Godordained. (Lydda, Sharon, Joppa)

Act 10 – A Gentile, Cornelius & Peter receive visions instructing them to meet each other

Acts 10:34 – Peter begins to speak regarding why He thinks that the Lord has drawn him here to Cornelius

God has a mission to accomplish through all those that are ready...are you ready?.....Peter is ready!

Today, 3 Indicators Jesus is leading God's church

1st Indicator: He Defeated Death (Chap 10:34-42)

**We know Jesus Christ is leading b/c it's His death& resurrection that opens the way into something newRead Vs 34-35

- 1. The message of the cross is for everyone!
- 2. This isn't saying that all that live 'good' are accepted into everlasting life
 - a. It means all those that fear God & strive for goodness will be given the truth of Jesus Christ
 - b. Peter's point is to say, these folks are NOT EXCLUDED from being given the Gospel

Read Vs 36-38

- 1. Vs 38 Jesus went about doing good
 - a. But this was his day to day life
 - b. Not His ultimate mission
- 2. Vs 36 Apostles; preaching peace "by Jesus"
 - a. His mission was to bring peace between God & man

Read Vs 39-40

- 1. Christ paid the price for others, not Himself
- 2. God the Father confirmed it by raising Him back to life forever.
- 3. The Apostles only role is to be witnesses
 - a. To share this message
 - i. What they have, to give to others

Read Vs 41-42

- 1. They were chosen b/c they would be strong witnesses, having been with Christ
- 2. They were to focus on Jesus' power over death
 - a. He became the Judge of those alive & deadb/c He defeated death and now owns it!
 - b. His resurrection proves He's Lord over all
 - i. Turn to Col 1:15-21
 - ii. Over, people, over spiritual powers
 - iii. He owns all by virtue of creating it
 - iv. He owns all by virtue of redeeming it!

We Know Jesus Is Leading God's Church B/c (App)

- 1. It's His work that has the power to defeat death
- 2. So, we don't have to earn salvation day by day
- 3. So, we're not offering our amazing church or
 - our own greatness, we're offering Christ Crucified
 - a. Lead people to follow Christ, He has power over death, not us.

2nd Indicator: He Grants Everlasting Life (Chap 10:43-48)

Read Vs 43

- Jesus not only has the power to judge everyone b/c He defeated death; but He will offer forgiveness to those who come to Him.
- 2. Read Isa 53:11
- 3. The only way to gain everlasting life is to come thru Jesus Christ...who earned it.

Read Vs 44-48

- 1. No formula/order for these things to occur.
 - a. Acts 2:38 (Jeru) Word, Baptized, Spirit
 - b. Acts 8:12-17 (Samaria) Word, Baptized, then later the laying on of hands, Spirit
 - c. Acts 9:18 (Paul) Word, then Bap & Spirit
 - d. Acts 10 (Here) Word, Spirit then baptize
 - e. The only requirement is the preaching of Christ and His powerful resurrection!
- 2. The rituals (laying on of hands & baptism) are pictures to help us (& the world) better understand what's happening in this transaction
 - a. God is the One who grants life and the H.S.
 - b. When person makes that secret transaction within their individual heart, God brings life.

We know Jesus Is Leading God's Church B/c (App)

- 1. It's Him that grants everlasting life
- 2. So, we should take the pressure off ourselves
 - a. We preach, but He saves those who come

3rd Indicator: He Puts People Together To Share His Gospel (Chap 11:1-17)

Read Vs 1-3

- 1. Peter is confronted by Jewish Believers
- 2. Their problem: "Why did you go to unclean Gentiles to eat and fellowship?"
- 3. Peter will have to explain how he was put together with these Gentiles.
- 4. Side Note: Notice how believers are referred to– as those that "received the Word of God".

Read Vs 4-12

- 1. So Peter rehearses his vision from God
 - a. Witnessing to unbelievers OR to the Church is just explaining what's already happened
- 2. He's explaining how God brought them together
 - a. As God teaches and grows us, we become more available in other's lives.
 - b. God molds us to have His vision, not our own.

Read Vs 13-14

- 1. Peter rehearses Cornelius' vision from God
- 2. This is just a retelling of what GOD did to bring them together
- 3. Remember, it's not given to angels to minister the Gospel, it's Christian's jobs.
- 4. So if "wit" is "having understanding"
 - a. God puts together the witness w/ the witless
 - b. This is His doing, to bring "light unto the Gentiles". (Luke 2:32)
 - c. Read II Cor 4:6 God's light has been given to us to share
 - d. Turn to Acts 13:46-47 This is indeed the reason that we meet the people that we do.

Read Vs 15-17

- 1. Peter rehearses the giving of the Spirit
- 2. Once the people were obedient to come together; God took over.

- a. Would to God that He would take over all things that we do
- b. I prep Bible Studies; but prefer it when the Lord gives spontaneous verses from His Word thru-out the prepared remarks from His Word.

We know Jesus Is Leading God's Church B/c (App)

- 1. It's Him that puts people together to share His Gospel
- 2. So, let's look around at the people God has ordained to be in our lives.....
 - a. These are the ones we're supposed to share Christ with!

Here's The Real Question: Are We Willing To Accept God's Lead? (Chap 11:18)

Read Vs 18

- 1. Their Problem:
 - a. "You went to unclean men?"
- 2. Their Answer:
 - a. "So God has cleansed the Gentiles!"
- 3. This was a paradigm shift for them
 - a. They couldn't imagine that God would cleanse the Gentiles.
 - b. New life changes everything
 - i. Don't consider the old life
 - ii. We can't consider the old life
- 4. They accepted that it was God that was doing a work...and that's all that mattered.

Conclusion

So, we've seen 3 Indications that Jesus is leading God's Church

1. Jesus is leading b/c He defeated death

- a. He's done all the work
- b. We don't have to earn salvation day by day
- c. We're not offering church, or self, we're offering Christ's death & resurrection
- *d.* Are you willing to accept that?

2. Jesus is leading b/c He grants everlasting life

- a. He hasn't just gained power over death, but He freely/continually is offering it out!
- b. We should take the pressure off ourselves; we do the preaching He does the saving!
- c. *Are you willing to accept that?*

3. Jesus is leading b/c He puts people together to share His Gospel

- a. Become ready witnesses; go where He leads.
- b. We're designed to preach to those around us
- c. *Are you willing to accept that?*
