Romans 10 – 31 January 2021 "Religious Paralysis"

Introduction

- *Paul wrote to the Roman church the greatest document on our salvation that there is
- *Rom 1-8 describes our natural unrighteous state and the solution of believing that the cross of Christ paid on way into a right relationship with God
- *Rom 9-11 Paul turns his attention to Israel
- *Rom 12-end is the application of righteousness to all the arenas of our life
- *In chap 9-11 Paul looks chronologically at Israel

Chap 9 – What happened to Israel all being saved?

Today in Chap 10 – What's their condition now?

Chap 11 – What will be Israel's end state?

We'll see 4 things that religious people need to do

1st Thing that religious people need to do: Let go of unbiblical traditions & self-effort (Vs 1-4)

Read Vs 1

- 1. This desire hearkens back to chap 9:2-3
- 2. Notice Paul puts desire into action by prayer
 - a. Noticed I complain sometimes, "why aren't certain people growing closer to the Lord"?
 - b. Instead of complaining, I've more & more put this desire into action by praying for them
 - c. As you pray, you find more action you can do for them!

Read Vs 2

- 1. Some have truth of God but no fervor.
 - a. They need to come alive by the Holy Spirit and get on mission, time is short
- 2. Jews & others have passion but w/o the truth.
 - a. Jews, Muslims...Pennsylvanians
- 3. They have passion...but unbiblical traditions
 - a. Some traditions are good

- b. Some traditions are prioritized higher than serving God
- c. Some traditions are flat out unbiblical
- 4. Read Mat 15:1
 - a. When tradition is untrue get rid of it
 - i. Mary is the co-redemptrix wrong
 - b. But also when tradition trumps love, unity of the brethren and God's Word get rid of it
- 5. Paul knew state they're in, b/c he was there!!
 - a. Read Gal 1:14 & II Tim 1:3 He has always had zeal for God
 - b. Read I Tim 1:12-15 Paul admits, in his self-effort & tradition…he had things wrong!

Read Vs 3-4

- 1. What knowledge do the Jews lack?
 - a. That you can't gain right-ness w/ God by and thru yourself.
 - b. Christ can give us that right relationship w/ God.
- 2. Passion w/o truth is proud and unbending

2nd Thing that religious people need to do: Humbly confess Christ as Lord over all arenas of life (Vs 5-13) Read Vs 5-8

- 1. Moses even made the case:
 - a. Righteousness could never be attained thru actions of doing...as if we can help Christ
 - b. Righteousness comes thru beliefs that come out thru the lips.
- 2. Notice vs 8 the "word of faith"
 - a. It has a substance it's founded in JESUS
 - b. We're saved thru speaking faith in Christ
 - c. This isn't about gaining frivolous things thru speaking faith in...what, our own words. (Name it & claim it, blab it & grab it)
 - i. We don't put faith in our will
 - ii. We put faith in Christ's work on the cross
- 3. All religions of man around world are based on man earning standing, we're different!
 - a. Turn to Matt 23:2-5, 11-12 humility

Read Vs 9-11

- 1. Believing Jesus rose from the dead will come out of your mouth as making Him <u>master</u> of all.
 - a. Lord/Master to a Gentile equates to Caesar
 - i. Are you willing to anger Caesar by putting him second place?
 - b. Lord to Jew equates to God Himself (LXX)
 - i. Are you willing to recognize Jesus as God?
- 2. Are there people in your life that you've never confessed Jesus to?
- 3. Belief in Christ Jesus will be accepted as entrance to God's presence
- 4. For anyone who got nervous in chap 9 w/ God choosing some to be saved...notice vs 11
 - a. All are welcome to come & God already knows who you are!

Read Vs 12-13

- 1. Confession of faith in Christ is for anyone!
- 2. Jews get saved the same way as the Gentiles

3rd Thing that religious people need to do: Receive the Word of God spoken to them (Vs 14-17)

Read Vs 14-15

- 1. So work this backwards & here's the process
 - a. Need people to be <u>sent</u> to unbelievers, then they can <u>preach</u>.
 - b. Then the unbelievers can <u>hear</u> & <u>believe</u>, then these new believers can <u>appeal</u> to God
- 2. There's more than just hearing the Word
 - a. Read Jam 1:21 Receive it into your life

Read Vs 16-17

- 1. Faith coming by hearing the "spoken" and written word of God.
 - a. Back then, most people would only have the spoken Word of God
 - b. So if you want to increase your faith, study the Word of God.

- 2. This is the process of people getting saved, but they don't all receive it
 - a. In Luke 8 Jesus wanted telling the Parable of the Sower & the Seed talked about how different people hear & some receive the Word
 - i. After telling the parable w/o interpretation, He sent them away
 - ii. Disciples, who wanted to receive it, asked Him what the parable means.
 - iii. Therefore, He gave them the understanding of the parable...b/c they asked to receive it!
- 3. Similar to us today, Israel had the Word of God all around them, but many did not receive it!
- 4. Honing in on the 4th step of <u>belief</u>, notice, it's the Word of God that needs to be believed, not the speaker or some opinions.
 - a. Read Jer 26:1-3 Don't take away from God's Word but give it all
 - b. Read I Thes 2:13 Also, don't add to God's Word by giving our opinion

4th Thing that religious people need to do: Stop the animosity w/ Christian friends (Vs 18-21)

Read Vs 18

- 1. Israel had every reason to look to God instead of self including creation.
- 2. Creation cries to them of a savior (Psm 19)
 - a. The 12 stars of the Mazzaroth (Zodiac) calls for the virgin (virgo) to give birth to Messiah
 - b. Even creation knowledge leads you to look to God for salvation and not self
- 3. Even though Gentiles are getting saved, God hasn't held back from telling all Jews across the world of His love and salvation offered to them.

Read Vs 19-20

- 1. Didn't Israel know salvation is available to all?
 - a. Moses (Deut 32:21) & Isaiah (Isa 65:1) spoke of people other than Jews being in relation w/ God
 - b. Jesus spoke of others coming to Him in John 16:10
- 2. Jews had such contention with people who loved God...even other Jews
 - a. Read Mark 9:38-41
 - b. God has a big tent, be happy when others come to Him, even if they don't look like you!

Read Vs 21

- 1. God is always available to offer Israel His grace & love, but they won't come and receive it!
- 2. He's a gentleman Read Hosea 5:15
- 3. Religious people build up pride, bitterness toward others and even anger. Pray for them by name and put your faith into action.

Conclusion

So Israel, like religious people today, need a change to align their life with God's will.

Maybe we fall into these tendencies

1. Let go of unbiblical traditions & self-effort

a. If what we're doing doesn't agree with scripture, are you willing to change it?

2. Humbly confess Christ as Lord over all

- a. We shouldn't be trying to work our way to the top.
- b. We should be trying to promote Christ to the top.

3. Receive the spoken Word of God

- a. Knowing & hearing aren't good enough.
- b. Receive God's truth...all of it

4. Stop the animosity w/ Christian friends

a. When others talk about religion, don't be offended, but start by asking yourself, "Is what they're saying Biblical?" Stop the contention!
