#### Leviticus 6-10 -6 August 2020 "How To Be A Christian Priest"

#### Introduction

Leviticus – Pertaining to the Levites

Leviticus 1-5 presented the 5 sacrificial offerings in the Law of Israel – they picture the cross of Christ

The Levitical offerings showed us the detail of what it means to accept Christ's sacrificial offering on cross

In Lev 6-7 we see more details to these offerings

Then in Lev 8-10 we'll see the first institution of the first Levitical priests

As Christians, we too are all priests to God (Read I Pet 2:5) – We have a job to do as a Christian Priest

Let's look at some further details to the 5 offerings that we saw in chap 1-5...and then in chap 8-10

### We'll Examine our 3 Assignments As Being A Christian Priest

Chap 6-1-7 – Finishes describing The Trespass Offering

Read Chap 6:1-7

1. Our trespass against our brother effect our relationship w/ the Lord (Matt 5:23-24) Restore our relationship with our brother first

Chap 6:8-13 – Further info about the Burnt Offering Read Chap 6:8-13

1. The long-burning offering is a great picture of whole dedication and slow sanctification over time

Chap 6:14-23 – Further info about the Grain Offering Read Chap 6:14-23

1. These were shared w/ the priests unless it was a grain offering of consecration the priests then had it burnt.

Chap 6:24-30 – Further info about the Sin Offering Read Chap 6:24-30

1. Sin offering isn't a sweet savor offering so the vessels the meat is cooked in had to be cleaned properly

Chap 7:1-10 – Further info about the Trespass Offering

Read Chap 7:1-10

- 1. The priest that did the work, had the right to divide up the meat
- 2. Incentive to perform the role, b/c it blesses you

Chap 7:11-38 – Further info about the Peace Offering Read Chap 7:11-13

1. Offering is unleavened but he should add leavened bread

Read Chap 7:14

1. Heave is up and down

Read Chap 7:15-18

1. Fellowship needs to be fresh not stale

Read Chap 7:19-21

1. Only the clean may eat

Read Chap 7:22-27

1. Israel isn't to take the parts that belong to the Lord

Read Chap 7:28-38

1. Wave is back and forth as if sacrificing it on the altar, but it's for the priests

### Now in Chap 8-10 We Examine our 3 Assignments As Being A Christian Priest

# Our 1<sup>st</sup> Assignment In The Christian Priesthood is: Be A Devoted Disciple (Chap 8:1-36)

Read Chap 8:1-13

- 1. So we see the consecration of the priests, setting them apart to do the role of a priest.
- 2. Notice tabernacle & priests are sanctified w/ oil just as we are sanctified w/ anointing of the H. S.

#### Read Chap 8:14-17

1. So after they get dressed, the 1<sup>st</sup> offering that needs performed in a Sin Offering for the priest's consecration.

#### Read Chap 8:18-21

1. Next is the Burnt Offering for the priest's consecration.

#### Read Chap 8:22-25

- 1. Ram of consecration to show Identification
  - a. Vs 23 Blood applied to the ear
    - i. Open to hearing the Word of God
    - ii. Jesus often said, "To him who hath ears to"
  - b. Vs 23 Blood applied to the right thumb
    - i. My service offered wholly to God
    - ii. Read Rom12:1 we should be wholly devoted as a sacrifice
  - c. Vs 23 Blood applied to right big toe
    - i. Everywhere I go is for you Lord
- 2. Notice the order of the offerings
  - a. Sin Offering Sin needs dealt w/ FIRST
  - b. Burnt Offering Now my life can be wholly dedicated to God, having dealt w/ sin.
  - c. Now can be Peace O. of communion & GrainO. of worship as my life more reflects U Lord.

#### Read Chap 8:26-36

1. So Moses performs the consecration

# Our 2<sup>nd</sup> Assignment In The Christian Priesthood is: Be A Blessing To Believers (Chap 9:1-36)

#### Read Chap 9:1-2

- 1. Aaron now takes over as priest now that he's consecrated to the office.
- 2. He now offers a Sin O. & Burnt O. for himself Read Chap 9:3-4
  - 1. Aaron now offers for the people
    - a. Sin, Burnt, Peace & Grain
    - b. W/ sin dealt w/ & dedication made, there can be fellowship & worship & deepness.
  - 2. Aaron is now able to speak properly for the people to God.
- 3. Today is the big day the Lord will show up! Read Chap 9:5-14
  - 1. Aaron performed the offering for himself
  - 2. Jesus didn't have to offer for Himself
    - a. Read Heb 7:26-27

#### Read Chap 9:15-21

- 1. Aaron now offers for the people
- 2. Read I Pet 2:9 We are to shine the truth of Who God is to those around us.
- 3. As we lead others with a true & pure lifestyle, it's a purifying effect on everyone around.

#### Read Chap 9:22-24

- 1. Aaron blessed the people w/ Num 6:24-26
- 2. ALL THE PEOPLE are blessed by Aaron and with the glory of the Lord. Why?
  - a. B/c they approached God correctly
  - b. B/c they accepted who they are & Who God is.

### Our 3<sup>rd</sup> Assignment In The Christian Priesthood is: Beware Of Spurious Stimulants (Chap 10:1-20)

#### Read Chap 10:1-5

- 1. Nadab & Abihu got caught up in the emotion and took matter into their own hands
- 2. See it wasn't their priestly coats that made them holy, it was serving the Lord properly that made them holy.
- 3. This is the day they've been longing for ever since their rebellion & repentance!!!
- 4. Many are stirred by emotion to do what they wouldn't normally do with time to think about it.
  - a. Read Jer 17:9 "The heart is deceitful..."

#### Read Chap 10:6-7

1. Although God takes no pleasure in the death of the wicked (Exe 33:11), These priests represent God and God doesn't mourn when sin is judged.

#### Read Chap 10:8-11

- 1. The Lord wants His teachers & representatives to be clear-headed and able to teach.
- 2. You can't be under a false stimulant and
  - a. Be clear-headed to represent God
  - b. Guide those around you
- 3. Read Eph 5:18
  - a. Don't be controlled by false stimulants leading to poor judgement
  - b. Be controlled by the Holy Spirit leading to a godly direction for your life.

#### Read Chap 10:12-15

1. So the offering meat is apportioned

#### Read Chap 10:16-20

- 1. Aaron is saying, "Would the Lord really have accepted it with all this grief in my heart?"
- 2. So Moses was content

#### Conclusion

So we've now seen the priesthood introduced to Israel. We can learn principles of our Christian Priesthood from it.

#### 1. Be a Devoted Disciple

- a. Our ears, our hands, our feet...all dedicated to God's service
- b. There's a growth process
  - i. As we confess sin (Sin O,), we then dedicate wholly (Burnt O.) to Him

#### 2. Be a Blessing to Believers

a. Your proper Godly example shines a glorious light into a dark world.

#### 3. Beware of Spurious Stimulants

- a. Whether it's being driven by emotion or intoxicants, they will impair your judgement.
- b. Be driven be the Holy Spirit, ask Him today!!!
