Genesis 15-17 – 10 October 2019 "Belief + Nothing = Righteousness"

Introduction

Chapter 12 begins with Abraham making a great commitment to God by leaving Ur of the Chaldees and coming into the land of Canaan.

Chapter 12-14 – then shows us Abram, the peacemaker, his resilience, his loyalty and integrity.

Chapter 15-17 is the primary Biblical text showing us that Belief + Nothing = Righteousness

Tonight, we'll see the 3 parts of this principle.

Chapter 15 presents the 1st part of the principle: the <u>Truth about Belief</u>

1. Read Vs 1

- a. The "Word of the Lord" came to him refers to Jesus Himself.
- b. "Fear not" Even after great spiritual victory, we can still get depressed.
- c. "Shield" After this great battle, he knows that he needs this.
- d. "Reward" God says, I have everything that you want and need.
- 2. Read Vs 2
 - a. Lord if you're my reward that what is it!?!
- 3. Read 3-5
 - a. The promise that in his old age he will have a son!
 - b. Abe just got reminder of vastness of God.
 - c. Exp: Praying for \$100 to pay the rent and the Lord's trying to give you \$2000!
- 4. Read Vs 6
 - a. As farfetched as it was, he believed
 - b. Turn to Rom 4:1-8

- c. Abe's works, weren't that great...good thing righteousness comes thru faith.
- 5. Read Vs 7-12
 - a. This is an ancient custom of ratifying an agreement, except, in this case, only one party will pass between the sacrificial animals.
 - b. Abe has nothing to do w/ keeping the deal.
 - i. Just needs to believe that God will keep it.
- 6. Read Vs 13
 - a. God now prophesies of Abe's future seed.
 - b. 400 years? Now Read Exo 12:40
 - i. Wow how many see a contradiction here.
 - ii. Sojourned 430 yrs and afflicted 400 yrs
- 7. Read Vs 14-16
 - a. God's having grace on the Canaanites yet!
- 8. Read Vs 17-21
 - a. They never did have enough faith to go possess all the land that God promised them.
 - b. Only piece of earth that has a title deed straight from God the Father.

Chapter 16 presents the 2nd part of the principle: the <u>Tragedy of adding anything to belief.</u>

- 1. Read Vs 1-4
 - a. Since God promised kids to Abe, Sarai now thinks the problem of no kids is with her.
 - b. Sarai was looking at the wrong problem.
 - i. Sarai not having babies wasn't a problem
 - ii. Sarai unbelief/lack of patience was problem.
 - c. Sarai's only real problem (lack of faith) lead her to much bigger problems (w/ Hagar)
 - d. MANNA Sometimes we think we have problems, but if we just wait for God's timing and believe God, it's no problem at all.
- 2. Read Vs 5-6
 - a. Contention needed never to happen
- 3. Read Vs 7-12
 - a. God's call and promises here to Hagar
 - b. Beginning of Arab people (flesh & Spirit)
- 4. Read Vs 13-16
 - a. Notice Hagar's obedience/faith in returning.

Chapter 17 presents the 3rd part of the principle: the <u>Triumph of God's grace for righteousness</u>

- 1. Read Vs 1-8
 - a. Abram will now be Abraham
 - i. "Father Exalted" to "Father of Nations"
 - b. The covenant is reconfirmed with Abraham and his descendants to come.
 - c. Notice in vs 8 the covenant is specifically tied to the land of Canaan.
 - d. Aren't you glad God doesn't throw us away and start over every time we have a lapse of faith?
 - i. Everything about the Ishmaelites was "in the flesh" on Abraham's behave.
 - ii. God again, in vs 1, called Abe to be upright, but is willing to continue to provide His grace!
- 2. Read Vs 9-14

- a. So circumcision was the sign of the covenant that would remind Abe of his relationship with the Lord.
- b. It would be an unseen reminder to each other that they were set apart from the flesh to think and do and be spiritual people!
- c. Stephen challenged the Israelites (Read Act 7:51) to be ready, to be different.
 - i. Circumcision is the cutting away of the flesh to leave only the essential.
 - ii. Stephen says even our heart and ears can be uncircumcised.
- d. Paul later in Rom 2:25 reminds us the circumcision was a sign of the covenant give to Abe and later to the people of Israel.
 - i. If you're going to keep the law of circumcision, you're indebted to do all!
 - ii. Read Rom 3:30

3. Read Vs 15-22

- a. So the son of promise will be thru Sarah and will be named Isaac (or laughter).
 - i. The covenant to be passed down to Isaac and not thru Ishmael.
 - ii. Abraham here laughs at the promise of God
 - iii. In chap 18 Sarah will also laugh when told of God's promise.
 - iv. A gentle rebuke from God
 - 1. Isaac's name means laughter.
 - 2. Abe & Sarah didn't believe this was to happen.
 - 3. Imagine the day that their unbelief turned to belief & they KNEW they were having a baby.
 - 4. They would have sat shamefaced
 - 5. Then thankful for God's grace.
- b. Notice God's love/grace toward Ishmael.
 - i. Abe has more kids (Gen 25) but Ish blessed
 - ii. There's no reason to despise the Arabs

- 4. Read Vs 23-27
 - a. Abraham obeys
 - b. For 13 yr olds and grown men this would be a painful action with no real pain killers.
 - c. The ability to return to God in obedience after such betrayal is just amazing grace!

Conclusion -

Today we've looked at the 3 parts of the Belief + Nothing = Righteousness principle

- 1. The truth about belief
 - a. Abe believes God and he was considered righteous.
- 2. The tragedy of adding anything to belief
 - a. Our real problems are unbelief not the tangible, temporary problem our eyes are on.
- 3. The triumph of God's grace in righteousness
 - a. His arms are always open to forgiveness.
