## Exodus 30-31 – 2 July 2020 "Our Part In Redemption As Pictured In The Tabernacle"

### **Introduction**

Moses has come up to top of Mt Sinai for 40 days. God will give him & Israel 2 things:

- 1. The Law We've seen this in chapter 19-24
- 2. The Tabernacle in chapter 25-31

<u>The Law</u> – how to represent God to the world

<u>The Tabernacle</u> – God representing Himself to Israel

God's plan in representing Himself in the Tabernacle is to show how He will redeem human kind

- 25-27 Most parts of Tabernacle; these represent Jesus Christ (Christ's part)
- 28-29 The High Priest and other priests (Mediator)
- 30-31 Rest of parts of Tabernacle; these represent our part in redemption (**Our Part**)

Today, we see our 6 parts in redemption as pictured in the Tabernacle

### 1st Part – Believe we need to depend on God in prayer (Chap 30:1-10) – The Altar of Incense

### Read Chap 30:1-8

- 1. So the construction similar to all other items.
  - a. Wood overlaid with gold
  - b. Staves or poles to move when relocating
- 2. Burning incense 2x a day everyday continually

### Application

- 1. Incense before the Lord is a picture of prayer
- 2. Read Rev 5:8
- 3. Prayer is designed for us to show our dependence on God
  - a. First part of redemption is coming to God saying, "I'm helpless, I depend on YOU".
  - b. Our Father from Matt 6:9-13
- 4. Turn to Luke 18:9-14 Two men went to pray
  - a. Prayer will reveal to YOU, if you're depending on God or self.

#### Read Chap 30:9-10

- 1. It's an altar but not for anything else but prayer
  - a. It's not the place sacrificial atonement is made, it's the place where sacrificial atonement is enjoyed.
  - b. In Leviticus 10, Aaron's sons Nadab & Abihu try their own formula and die for it.
  - c. Prayer: meant to enjoy relationship w/ God, not to demonstrate our own ways & efforts.

# 2<sup>nd</sup> Part – Believe we're all equally lost and redeemed (Chap 30:11-16) – The Atonement Money Read Chap 30:11-14

- 1. 20 was the apparent age of full adulthood
- 2. No census could be taken save God asks for it
  - a. You can only # what belongs to you

#### Read Chap 30:15-16

- 1. This atonement money was same amt for all
  - a. The ground is level at the cross
  - b. What God expects of you, He expects of me
  - c. Designed to show, we all owe God equally!
    - i. We all owe Him our very life
- 2. This one-time tax would later become the annual "Temple Tax" seen in Matt 17
  - a. See, Jesus says He doesn't owe this because He's already a perfect member of the Kingdom
  - b. But Jesus paid it anyway as to not offend needlessly.

### Application

- 1. This isn't a picture of NT guidelines for giving
  - a. NT giving we give as God prospers us
- 2. This is a picture of redemption being equal for all people.
  - a. Do you believe that we're all equally lost?
  - b. Do you believe that we're all equally saved?

### 3rd Part – Believe we're sanctified by the Word

(Chap 30:17-21) – *The Brass Laver* 

Read Chap 30:17-21

- 1. So a giant basin of washing water
- 2. What is water used to represent in the Bible?
  - a. Drinking water (John 4) Women at well
    - i. Read John 7:37-39
    - ii. Drinking water pictures the Holy Spirit
  - b. Washing water
    - i. Read Eph 5:26
    - ii. Washing water pictures the Word of God
- 3. We're told in Exo 38:8 this laver was made from the women's looking-glasses or mirrors.
  - a. Isn't a mirror a great pictures of the Word of God.
  - b. Read James 1:23-25
- 4. John 13:8-10 Jesus washing their feet
  - a. This is a continual need, not a full bath
  - b. Just as priests were to continually wash H/F

# 4<sup>th</sup> Part – Believe we gain God's power thru the Holy Spirit (Chap 30:22-33) – *The Anointing Oil* Read Chap 30:22-30

- 1. What was the use of this compound?
  - a. To be poured on Tabernacle's furniture
  - b. To be poured on all the priests
- 2. It was to signify that they have been set apart as special and different for a dedicated purpose
  - a. You have had the HS poured into your life
  - b. He's set you apart with power to serve God

### Read Chap 30:31-33

- 1. There is only one Holy Spirit
- 2. It was a specific prescription to make
- 3. Hb. Messiah a& Gk. Christ = Anointed One or Chosen One.
  - a. Anointing means to be chosen for power and position.
  - b. Read I John 2:27-28
    - i. Who is it that teaches all things? Jhn 14:26

### <u>Interlude – A Warning about the making of the incense</u> (Chap 30:34-38)

Read Chap 30:34-36

1. So just as the anointing oil, the incense has set ingredients.

Read Chap 30:37-38

- 1. The purpose of the incense is for the Lord to smell the prayers of the people, no one else.
  - a. Think of that next time someone says you can pray to Mary, a dead saint or an angel.
  - b. Don't cheapen prayer by thinking that you can have that special connection with someone other that God.
    - i. It's a special connection, brought thru the veil of Christ to God the Father Himself.
- 2. Remember prayer shows your dependence.
  - a. Don't offer your service to another.
    - i. That's idolatry!

### 5<sup>th</sup> Part – Believe we each have a purpose in life (Chap 31:1-11) – *Like Bezaleel & Aholiab*

Read Chap 30:1-11

- 1. Bezaleel and Aholiab are gifted and empowered for THIS task.
  - a. Moses was empowered...but not for this task.
  - b. Aaron was empowered...but not for this task.
- 2. This is important part to being saved/redeemed
  - a. There is a specific purpose for you
  - b. YOU specifically are important to God!
  - c. Matt 10:30 says that very hairs of your head are numbered.
    - i. He can't say that unless he's talking about an individual!

### 6<sup>th</sup> Part – Believe God has completed the work of redemption (Chap 31:12-18) – Sabbath Rest

Read Chap 30:12-13

- 1. Keeping the Sabbath was a way for Israel to show that world that they were redeemed, the work was done.
- 2. They've now been set apart as different/special Read Chap 30:14-18
  - 1. Many parts of the OT Law are helpful in principle today, but Sabbath is different.
    - a. Vs 17 It's between Israel and God
    - b. What's it for?
      - i. It remembers God's finished work of Creation.
      - ii. It's to anticipate the work that Christ will finish on the cross!
  - 2. Read Heb 4:10-11
    - a. Do you believe Christ's death finishes your payment for eternal existence w/ God?

#### Conclusion

So what's our part in the making of human redemption? **BELIEF** 

### 1. Believe we need to depend on God in prayer

a. Can't be saved unless you know you're helpless without God's intervention

### 2. Believe we're all equally lost & redeemable

a. Your salvation & my salvation costs same

### 3. Believe we're sanctified by the Word of God

 a. Once bathed, we only need continual washing away of daily sin

### 4. Believe we gain power thru the Holy Spirit

a. You have a new power, not of your own!

### 5. Believe we each have a great purpose

a. We're not just saved from Egypt, we're saved to the Promised Land...take advantage!

### 6. Believe God has completed the work

a. Are you resting on Christ's finished work? Knowing it doesn't depend on you?
