I Timothy 4 – 4 February 2024 "The Word Made Dangerous"

Introduction

- *For those of you that enjoy outlines, I Timothy's 6 chapters is outlined as TILDAS
 - *Teaching, Intimacy, Leaders, Dangers, Aged, & Suspicions
- *'Tilda' is French word from ancient Germanic for 'mighty in battle' or 'mighty in strength'
 - *Key verse of the book (Read) I Tim 1:18
- *Paul opened Chap 1 w/ the value of teaching
- *In Chap 2, he discusses a manner of praying & teaching in the church that brings intimacy
- *In Chap 3, we saw a Christian leader's character
- *Now in Chap 4, we see how the Word of God can actually become a thing unhelpful & even dangerous
- *Satan knows God's Word & used it for harm (Gen)

Today, we'll see 3 ways we can dangerously misuse the Word of God

#1 – There's the danger of denying the Word (Vs 1-5) Intro

- 1. No greater example than Satan in Gen 3:1 Read Vs 1
 - 1. Notice he's talking about people that have claimed to be Christians
 - 2. They've stopped trusting the Bible & started trusting teachings of men inspired by the devil
 - 3. When you stop trusting God's Word, you're deceived into believing anything
 - a. Read II Thes 2:10-11

- 1. Paul warned the Thessalonians (I Thess 5:19) not to quench the Spirit's work in their life
 - a. This verse is the result of doing that
 - b. They're past feeling the guilt of sin and now deceive others w/ lies to join them

Read Vs 3

- 1. There're always people that want to be superior to your Christianity b/c of their strict practices
- 2. 'Forbidding to marry' two ways we see this
 - a. Groups like Catholic priests are forbidden
 - b. Groups advise don't marry, just sleep around
- 3. 'Vegetarians' We know that truth; God put them here for our nourishment (Read Gen 9:3-4)

Read Vs 4-5

- 1. OT Kosher food laws were given to picture a distinction between clean & unclean
- 2. Once Jesus made a way for unclean to be clean, these prototypes went away (Read Acts 10:13-15)
 - a. "Where do you draw the line" sign
 - b. By the truth of God's Word & by prayer we partake & bless God for giving us nourishment

#2 – There's the danger of distracting from the Word (Vs 6-10)

Intro

- 1. Reminds you of Job's 4 friends 'other wisdom' Read Vs 6
 - 1. As servants of Christ, we want to constantly remind each other of the words of Christ
 - a. This's primary duty of pastors, but it's for all
 - b. We're leaky vessels that need constant filling
 - 2. God's Word is our spiritual food & nourishment
 - a. Drink up the $\underline{\text{milk}}$ get the basic idea
 - b. Tear into the $\underline{\text{meat}}$ go deep; connect ideas
 - c. Enjoy the manna Word applies to your life
 - 3. Notice, they've already attained the truth, by they need to continue in it can't say, "Oh I've already read that"

Read Vs 7-8

1. Avoid the myths of the ungodly & old women

- 2. Work on or keep building on godliness
- 3. So just like someone exercising the body, this is the method to exercise the spirit
 - a. Avoid myths & conspiracy theories & focus on a steady routine of taking in godliness
- 4. There are similarities between exercising the body & the spirit proper feeding & then exertion
- 5. Difference is exercising body is for temp gain whereas exercising spirit is eternal gain starting now

Read Vs 9-10

- 1. B/c God saved us; we have an expectation of good things to come
 - a. B/c of expectation, we labor to become godly
 - b. If we truly believe He saved us & we'll be with Him forever, wouldn't we want to become godlike in character that's godliness
- 2. Jesus has done the saving work for all
 - a. All that's left is for the individual to apply the Word for godliness

#3 – There's the danger of diminishing the Word (Vs 11-16)

Intro

- 1. Samuel to Saul: What is this bleating of sheep?
- 2. Saul: The people spared the best & we've destroyed the rest (I Sam 15:15)
- 3. But God told you to destroy them all

Read Vs 11

- 1. There should be a clarity that we have the Word of God; that should be spoken with authority
 - a. Jesus spoke as one having authority
- 2. We're not giving opinion but God's mind

- 1. Don't let people discourage you with qualifiers that aren't legitimate at all
- 2. Rather do everything to be an example of Jesus
 - a. Read II Cor 3:2 The world is watching us
 - b. Read II Cor 3:5 Praise God for His spirit's enablement

Read Vs 13

- 1. We'll never come to the end of taking in God's love thru His Word (Read Acts 2:42)
- 2. Again, we're leaky vessels that need reminded of what is good and what is harmful
- 3. What a wonderful thing that God has encapsulated what we need for this life in His Word
 - a. There's nothing more valuable to our souls than knowing Jesus in the fulness of his love

- 1. Paul's reminding Timothy that when the elders laid their hands on him, asking for the empowering of the Spirit, a word of prophecy came declaring that Timothy would be a pastor himself
 - a. The gift of prophecy isn't <u>new revelation</u> but an <u>application of</u> the Word of God
 - b. Phil 1:6 He that began a good work in you, we be faithful to complete it
 - c. Don't be tempted to turn to another method

Read Vs 15

- 1. Is our spiritual growth & interest in the Lord becoming more apparent every day?
 - a. It will as we're being renewed in our mind
- 2. We want to be so affected by the love & grace of God that it just comes spilling out on to others
 - a. It becomes contagious

- 1. So from vs 15 to vs 16, it's <u>meditate</u> and to make God's Word <u>a priority</u> in our lives
- 2. "To thyself and to the doctrine" We read the Word with a mind to apply it to our life
 - a. And what will it do, it will "save us"
- 3. Not just eternally save us, but save in this life
 - a. Save us from physical consequences
 - b. Save us from emotional consequences
 - c. Save us from financial consequences
 - d. Save us from relational loss

Conclusion

So, the Word became flesh in Jesus, let's not make the Word become dangerous by misusing it

1. There is a danger in denying the Word

- a. Don't be lifted up in pride placing yourself as superior over the Word of God
- b. Isa 40:8 The grass withers & the flower fades, but the Word of God stands forever!

2. There is a danger in being distracted from the Word

- a. There is no hidden knowledge 'out there' that you need apart from what God's revealed
- b. It has all the milk, meat & manna we need

3. There is a danger in diminishing the Word

- a. Don't drift away from seeing the Word in all its value and glory
- b. Where else shall we go Lord? You have the words of life
