## Mark 2:1-22 – 11 April 2021 "Peering Beyond our Physical Life"

## Introduction

- \*Jesus has begun travelling thru Galilee in the north
- \*Preaching all should repent & prepare for the Kingdom
- \*Jesus didn't ultimately come...
  - to deliver new doctrine (although He did)
  - to deal with deceivers (although He did)
  - to destroy demons (although He did)
- ...He ultimately came...to die... and be the Deliverer
- \*He came to deliver not from a physical bondage to Rome, but to deliver from our spiritual bondage to sin
- \*Jesus calls us to live beyond this earthly life, while in this life
- \*Christians are in this world, in this body, but not this world
- \*New life from Christ frees us to live not by the impulses of our body and physical world, but by the spirit of God that is within us

# Today we'll look at 3 parts of living the spiritual over the physical

# $1^{st}$ part of living the spiritual over the physical is the entrance is that of faith (Vs 1-12)

## <u>1-12 – Palsied Man lowered thru roof</u>

## Read Vs 1-2

- 1. Remember, He went about to preach & teach
  - a. The healings/miracles are a side effect
  - b. He's teaching of a spiritual kingdom that is a real reality behind this physical reality
- 2. Day's coming when they'll have to decide if they're following Him for the physical healings or for His offer of spiritual life (Read John 6:26-29)

## Read Vs 3-4

- 1. They believed Jesus could heal and help.
- 2. Their faith even pushed thru obstacles, b/c they believed!
- 3. Oh, to have friend that believe as you do!
- 4. Faith is the key that activates grace in our lives.
  - a. Jesus isn't obligated to help anyone

b. But He delights to grace those whose hearts are perfect toward Him

#### Read Vs 5

- 1. Jesus' forgiveness is activated b/c of their faith
  - a. It's a gift that becomes effective, when you believe it's effective and take it
- 2. Why say this? B/c it answered his greater need
  - a. If God only heals your spiritual problem and nothing else....IT IS ENOUGH!

## Read Vs 6-7

- 1. They didn't believe Jesus is God
- 2. Can only God forgive? (Psm 51:4 & Gen 39:9)
- 3. So, this is blasphemy if Jesus isn't God

- 1. Matthew says they said, "Why think ye evil?"
  - a. 'Why is your 1<sup>st</sup> thought that Jesus must be doing something wrong?'
- 2. First, find out if Jesus is speaking truth

## Read Vs 9-11

- 1. The word *power* is authority not *dunamis* 
  - a. Jesus has rightful position to forgive sins
- 2. Which is harder to do?
  - a. Well, for Jesus neither is hard
  - b. But He performs the physical act to prove the spiritual reality
- 3. Paralyzed man's friends believed / received
  - a. Scribes didn't believe so Jesus showed them openly had no choice but to accept it
  - b. Entrance into the Kingdom is by faith

- 1. From Matt "Marveled & glorified God who had given such authority unto men"
  - a. Ladies & Gentlemen, the man Jesus is God!
- 2. Where's this leading to?
  - a. All His works point to His teachings
  - b. All His teachings point to God
  - c. It's our part to believe!!

# 2<sup>nd</sup> part of living the spiritual over the physical is the activity is to leave & cleave (Vs 13-17)

# 13-17 – Publican Matthew called & repents

#### Read Vs 13

- 1. Like in vs 2 His purpose was to teach
- 2. He taught entrance into the Kingdom of God
- 3. He taught of accepting the spiritual by faith

- 1. Luke 5:28 says Matthew "left all", rose up & followed Jesus.
- 2. Jesus doesn't just call you 'to' but also 'away from' things.
  - a. Matthew Levi didn't start dragging his tax collecting booth behind him
  - b. To follow Christ is to leave what you know is wrong
  - c. When you married, you didn't agree to be w/ them, but you agreed to be w/ ONLY them

- 1. Just takes 1 to influence a whole group to come Read Vs 16-17
  - 1. Read Matthew 9:12-13
    - a. The quote is from Hos 6:6 but said more in I Sam 15:22
    - b. If the spiritual act isn't happening, then the physical act is worthless
  - 2. They're not mad that Jesus ate w/ "bad guys"
    - a. They're mad that they may lose their influence over people
    - b. They'd find a way to be mad at anyone who was taking away their power and control
      - i. Read Matt 11:16-19
  - 3. When you become a believer, the enemy is enraged b/c you've not only begun serving God, but you've left his service
  - 4. A woman <u>leaving</u> her family to <u>cleave</u> to another family is a picture of us coming to Christ!

# 3<sup>rd</sup> part of living the spiritual over the physical is the reward is new freedom & grace (Vs 18-22)

## 18-22 – Jesus is here to bring freedom & grace

## Read Vs 18-20

- 1. Why mourning?
  - a. Pharisees mourned longing for Messiah to deliver them from Roman
  - b. John Baptist's disciples mourned longing for Messiah to come
  - c. Jesus' disciples rejoiced in the presence of Messiah
  - d. Physical act of mourning/fasting (or not) has to correctly represent the spiritual reality
- 2. This is 1<sup>st</sup> reference to the heavenly wedding
  - a. Children of the bridegroom is Israel.
  - b. Bride is the church (Read Rom 7:4)
  - c. John the Baptist is the best man (Jhn 3:29)
  - d. Jesus is here on earth to take a bride!
- 3. There's a time to fast/mourn, this ain't it!!

## Read Vs 21-22

- 1. Explain the 2 analogies You can add the new to the old had to be two separate things
- 2. Jesus is here to complete the Law, but He's here to do something new also!
  - a. Read Rom 7:4 completion of the Law means dead to the 1<sup>st</sup> & freedom to live for another.
  - b. We live by a new standard...that of grace.
  - c. Read John 1:17 "grace and truth"
- 3. The reward of living the spiritual life is that of freedom to live in God's grace w/o condemnation!

## Conclusion

So the spiritual life is far greater than this earthly life! But how do we experience this life in the 4<sup>th</sup> dimension?

## 1. The entrance into it is by faith in Jesus

- a. There is a way to eternal life, there is a way to have your sins forgiven?
- b. Do you believe Jesus has healed you?

# 2. The activity is a constant leaving & cleaving

- a. I John 1:6: "If we say that we have fellowship w/ Him & walk in darkness, we lie, & do not the truth"
- b. The closer you grow to Christ, the more distant the cares of this world become

## 3. The reward is that of new freedom & grace

- a. In this physical world, we are bound to sin & toil
- b. Walking in the spiritual life, we find freedom
- c. I John 1:7: "But if we walk in the light, as He is in the light, we have fellowship 1 w/ another & the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanseth us from all sin."
