## II Samuel 5-7 –21 April 2022 "Eternal Life Pictured In David"

## **Introduction**

- \*II Samuel depicts the entire reign of King David \*This is also where I Chronicles begins
- \*II Samuel opened w/ David dealing w/ Saul's son having kept the throne & hearts of the 10 tribes
- \* That was resolved when Abner converted to the truth and came under the true king David
- \*Chap 5 now begins zenith of the Davidic Kingdom
- \*In this wonderful time for Israel, I believe God wants us to experience what it means for us to "come into the kingdom" as well
- \*The moment God brings all control of Israel under David; we see some events that speak of our own salvation & coming under God's control
- \*Today, we see the 3 steps into eternal life pictured in the life of King David

# 1<sup>st</sup> step into eternal life is salvation: We inherit by full dependence on God's strength (Chap 5:1-25)

## Read Chap 5:1-5

- 1. All Israel agree that God has placed David as the king over ALL of them
- 2. They admit even while Saul was king, David was living the life of someone worthy to be king
- 3. *App*: Ish-Bosheth tried taking whole kingdom
  - a. Ish-Bosheth tried in his strength & ways
  - b. David relied on God & His power to inherit

#### Read Vs 6-10

- 1. Jebusites are Canaanite people that mocked David saying they only needed blind & lame to defend Jerusalem (Jebus) against David
- 2. David asked for an invasion thru water tunnel & Joab (I Chr 11) took David up on the offer
- 3. Stronghold or castle of Zion is a part of modern Jerusalem that is south of the Temple Mount

- 4. *App:* Joshua briefly took Jebus but couldn't keep it in his own strength
  - a. David relied on God & His power to inherit
  - b. Same as our salvation it's not of our own craft, method or power, but God's ability

#### Read Vs 11-12

1. This foreign, young king to the north made peace & trade w/ David to which David perceived this as God's blessing to be used for ALL Israel

#### Read Vs 13-16

- 1. World sees this multiplying of David's family as good thing, but it would be his greatest anguish
  - a. Remember is against God's plan & will
  - b. Before you get high & mighty, know the avg American has almost the same # of partners in life just w/o the lifetime protection

#### Read Vs 17-21

- 1. David's tight relationship w/ God & dependence on His strength is on display AGAIN
- 2. When God tells you what to do, can't go wrong

#### Read Vs 22-25

- 1. God brought a wind thru trees to signal David that it was time to ambush them from behind
- 2. *App:* Saul tried beating the Philistines
  - a. Saul's strength / methods couldn't do it
  - b. David relied on God & His power to inherit

# 2<sup>nd</sup> step into eternal life is sanctification: We serve by treating God as special & people as equals (Chap 6:1-23)

## Read Chap 6:1-4

- 1. David's desire to bring the ark to Jerusalem is good but his method of using a new cart is bad
  - a. Ark was to be carried by the Kohathites by the poles thru the rings
- 2. David (& us all) are learning that God is glorified in, not just the ends but also the means

#### Read Vs 5

1. David made big event out of this & that's ok

#### Read Vs 6-7

- 1. This isn't a sin of reaction. They had time to plan to transport the ark...the wrong way
- 2. We say, 'I had no choice', at that moment, no
  - a. Choice was earlier when you used a cart, not poles.
  - b. Exp: Choice to have sex, not to abort
- 3. Ark was at Uzzah's house for some time & they made mistake to treating the holy as common

#### Read Vs 8-11

- 1. David goes 3 months w/ confusion b/c he never asked the Lord how to properly transport the ark & couldn't understand this death
- 2. Needed to learn to treat God, not just with love but also with holiness

# Read 12-14 – This is the 2<sup>nd</sup> attempt 3 months later

- 1. I Chr 15 details how David learned then instructed Kohathites to do as the Lord prescribed
- 2. Coming back to God's Word clears confusion

#### Read Vs 15-16

- 1. Nothing wrong w/ making a big production the 1<sup>st</sup> OR the 2<sup>nd</sup> time, be joyful in worship
- 2. Emotion is good is service to God
- 3. Don't commit the 2 great errors of emotion
  - a. Don't let your emotions lead or govern
  - b. Don't be detached from them

#### Read Vs 17-19

- 1. This was a great praise event!
- 2. I Chr 16 records David assigning priests to roles and singing a great psalm of praise

#### Read Vs 20-23

- 1. David wasn't uncovered, he just didn't have any kingly garments on
- 2. Michal expected David to 'put on airs', yet David was 'down to earth' she wanted to be associated w/ a special man not a common man
- 3. Don't ever let an earthly title prevent us from being a worshipping child of the King
- 4. It's not undignified to throw your joy at God

3<sup>rd</sup> step into eternal life is glorification: We receive good by having a heart to give to God (Chap 7:1-29)

## Read Chap 7:1-3

- 1. David didn't desire God to have a house.
- 2. David desired God to have better things than he

## Read Vs 4-7

- 1. God set the Judges to feed the people
- 2. God says, "I never asked for house", or anything

### Read Vs 8-11

- 1. David wouldn't build God (physical) house, but God's promised He would build David (spiritual) house
- 2. Principle: As you focus on God's glory, He focuses on your benefit (Read Hag 1:2-6)
  - a. Humble yourself & He'll exalt you in time

### Read Vs 12-15

- 1. The blessing of David will extend to Solomon
- 2. Solomon would build the Temple that David desired for God to have

#### Read Vs 16-17

- 1. The blessing of David will extend forever!
- 2. A forever throne has to be more than physical
  - a. This has to be that Messiah will be a man born unto David's family
  - b. The physical kingdom of David on earth will be interrupted by Babylon & others, but the spiritual kingdom never will be

### Read Vs 18-22

1. David expresses the greatness of God to give a small man such an honor

### Read Vs 23-24

1. David expresses what a great position God has placed the nation in

### Read Vs 25-29

- 1. So be it, let all your words be true O Lord!
- 2. Remember, David could have been mourning loss of what HE wanted, (building God a house), but he recognized that NOT getting his will was ever better!!

## Conclusion

So David has come into his inheritance showing us a picture of believers coming into our inheritance in God's Kingdom. Eternal life is a progression.

# 1. Salvation: We inherit by full dependence on God's strength, not our own

a. David came to his inheritance by God's grace & power...and so do we, not of our own

# 2. Sanctification: We serve by treating God as special & people as equals

a. David & us face many trials all designed to bring God glory & honor while seeing our sin

# 3. Glorification: We receive good by having a heart to give to God

- a. Ultimate aim for believers in Jesus is to be solely focused on exalting Him & in turn God sees fit to exalt us
- b. Read Mark 10:29-30 "Jesus answered & said, Verily I say unto you, there is no man that hath left house, brethren, sisters, father, mother, wife, children, or lands, for my sake, & the gospel's, but he shall receive 100-fold now in this time, houses, brethren, sisters, mothers, children, and lands, w/ persecutions; & in the world to come eternal life."
