### Psalms 112-115 – 16 November 2025 "Faith On Display"

### Introduction

- \*This is 3<sup>rd</sup> of about 12 messages in the 5<sup>th</sup> & final Book of Psalms
- \*In 1800s Charles Blondin became famous for crossing Niagara Falls on a tightrope (blindfolded, man on back, even on stilts)
  - \*Popularly he would cross pushing a wheelbarrow
- \*To a cheering crowd, he would ask if they believed he cross pushing a wheelbarrow, to which they cheered, "We believe, you can do it!"
- \*So he asked the man cheering the loudest to get in the wheelbarrow – but no one ever did
- \*We talk having faith as if it's something we can catch, but in fact, it's something that we do
- \*Today, we'll see 4 indicators that we're trusting Jesus as God & Savior in our lives

## #1: The faithful are fixed reverently on receiving righteousness from God (Psm 112)

### Read Psm 112:1

- 1. Happiness doesn't come by hearing of the right path, but by walking down the right path
  - a. Read Heb 11:6 Knowing & seeking are 2 different things
  - b. Read Psm 1:1-2 There is a path for joy
- 2. We will not choose this path of joy unless we have a great reverence for God

### Read Vs 2-3

- 1. This connects fear of God w/ righteousness
  - a. True love for God prompts us to reverence
  - b. True reverence for God prompts us to right living
- 2. This has real value as seen in the effects it has on our family and children

### Read Vs 4-6

1. Our direction is to do <u>our</u> works w/ justice, but to give gracious and lend (Quote Micah 6:8)

- 2. Look at the results
  - a. Vs 4 A way out of trouble will arise
  - b. Vs 6 Just ones will be remembered forever

#### Read Vs 7-8

- 1. The Bible speaks of Rehoboam doing evil b/c his heart wasn't set on God
  - a. Yet Jehoshaphat & Ezra are known for setting their hearts on God & prospering for it
- 2. The righteous have their heart is fixed on God
  - a. 'Who can mind the journey when the road leads home'
  - b. We trust that where God guides, He provides & He will take us there

### Read Vs 9-10

- 1. Now the classic divide between the righteous & the wicked
  - a. Do you see yourself as poor & needy regarding godliness? We should
  - b. Or are we the wicked
- 2. We can only obtain this righteousness if we come needy to receive God's free gift at the cross

## #2: The faithful exalt the One who came so low (Psm 113)

Into – 3 sections of Hallel Psalms (113-118 Egyptian Hallel), (136 Great Hallel), (145-150 Daily Hallel)

Egyptian Hallel are praise for deliverance from Egypt under Moses and sung at the Feasts

### Read Psm 113:1

- Look around, everyone is a slave to something
  a. We've chosen to be slaves to a good master
- 2. Someone's character is embedded in their name a. We praise the very character of our God

### Read Vs 2-3

- 1. Thru all of time and thru all of space, God is to be praised
- 2. There is no time period or place which He doesn't deserve to be exalted above all things

### Read Vs 4-6

1. The One that is above all things brings Himself low to pay regard to the affairs of man

- 2. Read Phil 2:5-9 He brought Himself so low as to identify with sinful man
  - a. He's worthy of exaltation b/c He's Creator
  - b. He's worthy of exaltation b/c He's Redeemer

### Read Vs 7-9

- 1. He descended so low for a purpose; to bring us up from it
  - a. We were the poor on the trash heap
  - b. We were the barren, w/o hope of a future
- 2. Praise God that He uses <u>His</u> glory to bring <u>us</u> into glory

# #3: The faithful live their own experiences with God (Psm 114)

### Read Psm 114:1-2

- 1. Israel's 3 deliverances thru history
  - a. From Egypt No nation became a nation
  - b. From Babylon Idolatrous nation became religious

- c. From Rome Religious nation became secular
- 2. Deliverance from Egypt was the central act of God's redemption thru OT Israel's existence
  - a. Primary reminder to them of God's faithfulness

### Read Vs 3-6

- 1. There was a power displayed at the deliverance of Israel that moved creation itself to pay attention
  - a. From the lg Red Sea to the sm Jordan River, from the large Mt Sinai to smaller mts, God will make a way, where there seems to be no way

#### Read Vs 7-8

- 1. These large events were meant to role-model what God wants to do in each individual life
- 2. Everyone and everything is called to give honor to the God of redemption
  - a. When our God calls a nation to be, it happens

# #4: The faithful are displaying God thru their lives (Psm 115)

Intro – As a Psalm of deliverance, we should picture this being sung by Israel as they leave Egypt

But certainly, Jesus would have sung this during His remembrances of the Passover Festival

#### Read Psm 115:1-2

- 1. Israel is proud of their God's guide for living and His goodness toward them
- 2. When nations look at Israel, they see God's work
  - a. God's ability is seen thru their deliverance& life
  - b. Is God "on display" thru our lives?

### Read Vs 3-8

- 1. Jesus Christ is the exact opposite of a manmade religion, He does do all these things
  - a. His mouth: speaks thru His Word; John 1:14

- b. His eyes: looks for whom He can help; II Chr 16:9
- c. His ears: are open when the righteous cry; Psm 34:15
- d. His nose: receives our prayers as incense; Rev 8:4
- e. His hands: molds us as pottery; Isa 64:8
- f. His feet: can so low as to become a man walk among us bring salvation; John 1:14
- g. Finally His voice: shakes the heavens & earth, yet calls out to sinners, as w/ Adam & Eve in the Garden to be saved (Gen 3:8)
  - i. Be warned, His very voice will yet smite all that don't receive His call for salvation
- 2. Whatever you're living for, whatever you serve; you will become like your god
  - a. Whether something of earth, you'll become vain
  - b. Whether God of heavens, you'll become victorious

### Read Vs 9-11

- 1. What are we trusting in for a great life
  - a. Just getting a little money & comfort, or getting taught & guiding by the hand of God?
- 2. What are we trusting in for eternity?
  - a. Just doing enough to slip in? It will never work
  - b. Just submitting to God's love to receive the gift of righteousness

#### Read Vs 12-15

- 1. These verses are the fulfillment of vss 9-11
- 2. Whoever trusts in the Lord, will be helped & blessed
- 3. Let's get a handle on what He wishes to increase
  - a. God's less interested in increasing the fruit in our fields & more interested in increasing the fruit in our hearts

### Read Vs 16-18

1. Those that have experienced receiving life from the dead are the ones designed to praise God

- 1. Are you fixed reverently on receiving righteousness from God & living in it?
- 2. Are you exalting Jesus, who came so low to rescue us?
- 3. Are you having your own experiences with the Lord in which He's challenging you?
