Psalms 104-105 – 3 August 2025 "Made With Promise, Molded To Secure Them"

Introduction

- *This is 5th of 6 messages in the 4th Book of Psalms
- *Psalms the Israeli Hymnbook or Book of Praises
- *Today Psm 104 speaks of God's detailed care in crafting our universe & environment just for us
- *Then Psm 105 follows it with an explanation of how difficulties bring greater blessings than we would have experienced otherwise
- *In all of this, God shows that He's focused on caring for us & producing great things thru us

#1 – We've been intricately created with an abundant environment (Psm 104)

Read Psm 104:1-2

- 1. Read Rom 1:20 & Psm 19:1
 - a. We learn of God thru studying His creation

- b. If His creation is this detailed & immense, how much greater is the God who made it
- 2. *Stretching out* is a Hb. qal participle simply meaning that this is present & ongoing action
 - a. We've found this to be true since the 1920s
 - b. Science of Redshift & Hubble's law shows the universe is still expanding to this day

Read Vs 3-4

- 1. The big point is that God's creation & even His angels, were created to serve & glorify Him
 - a. Even Heb 1:7 draws this point out that the angels were created to serve God
- 2. Creation is God's home, & place of activity
 - a. He didn't just spin this universe up & then leave it alone He's present & active

Read Vs 5-9

- 1. No doubt the reference of the earth covered in water speaks of both creation & Noah's flood
 - a. But the larger point is that earth was made to endure it cannot be shaken or removed
- 2. Even the wind & waves obey God's authority

Read Vs 10-13

- 1. Notice God's active role in satisfying the needs of His creation
- 2. God created w/ sustainment in mind He cares Read Vs 14-18
 - 1. The Lord created an intricately interwoven system that provides for the other parts
 - a. Water provides for the ground, the ground for vegetation, vegetation provides for man
 - b. Trees & mountains provide for the birds
 - 2. Nothing goes without its needs met
 - 3. A note about drinking alcohol
 - a. 3 verses about the benefit of wine do not speak against the prohibitions of drunkenness
 - i. Eph 5:18, Prov 20:1, Gal 5:19, I Cor 6:10
 - b. They also don't speak against the verses that tell us to avoid the appearance of evil

Read Vs 19-23

- 1. Even the heavens are servants to the earth
 - a. Read Gen 1:14 By them we track time

- 2. He made the moon for the seasons
 - a. *Seasons* aren't the 4 seasons we think of, it means appointed times or holidays
 - b. 4 seasons are caused by the 23.5-degree tilt
 - c. But we track our calendar months, dating & holidays by the moon, not just the sun's year

Read Vs 24-26

- 1. Leviathan that giant sea serpent, seems to be extinct today
- 2. The vast complexity & variety of creation
- 3. If you're looking for uncharted waters to explore, I would recommend...the waters
 - a. Only 20-25% of the seafloor has been mapped
 - b. Even less is known about the area between the surface and the seafloor
 - c. Don't think that we have God figured out... we barely have creation figured out

Read Vs 27-30

1. The dependence of all creation on God's provision – for life and food

- Notice each part is God's <u>action</u> & our <u>reaction</u>
 a. Even for food, God <u>gives</u> but we must <u>gather</u>
 Read Vs 31-35
 - 1. Some Psalms deal w/ man's effects on the earth, but then some Psalms, like this one, deal w/ the earth in its raw form apart from man's effects
 - 2. Even in the earth's corrupted form, we still see the immensity of God thru this massive creation
 - 3. Man should be forewarned by it; God is awesome & not to be trifled with

#2 – We're allowed difficult experiences to produce greater results (Psm 105)

Read Psm 105:1-3

- 1. This is impossible unless we're proud of Him
 - a. Do we hide the things we're proud of?
- 2. Are we a part of the activities listed here or do we think of our faith as just one-directional intake?

Read Vs 4-7

- 1. These 1st 7 verses are as the sound of a herald proclaiming to others the goodness of God
 - a. Are we His heralds today?
 - b. Are we telling people that they can call upon the Lord and be saved? (ie Psm 18:3)

Read Vs 8-12

- 1. Our God is <u>committed</u> to us
 - a. It's based in His infinite foreknowledge
 - b. It stays as a commitment forever
- 2. We serve a God that calls things that are not, as if there were (b/c they will be)
 - a. Even when Israel was no nation, He agreed to give them the land that they're in
 - b. Other than times of specific judgement or purpose, they've always possessed their land

Read Vs 13-15

1. While waiting for the promise of receiving their own land, God protected them

- a. He would not destruction of their <u>lineage</u>
 - i. Abe & Sarah w/ Pharoah (Gen 12)
- b. He would not allow their <u>number</u> to be wiped out in the time of Jacob (Read Gen 35:5)
- 2. Now this phrase touch not my anointed ones
 - a. Modern false teachers would say, 'every believer should walk in divine protection' (Samuel Arimoro 'Touch Not My Anointed!' Feb 20, 2025)
 - b. Yet this is specifically about someone God gave a specific promise to that would be protected until fulfillment
 - c. Read Gen 20:1-6 God told Abimelech to touch not my anointed
 - d. Bottom line: It's not a mandate for us to do whatever we want & walk in divine protection
 - i. It's a mandate God placed on Himself to keep His promises & protections toward us

Read Vs 16-22

1. Joseph was move with purpose and against his will to Egypt to fulfill a greater purpose

- a. Read Gen 50:20 In the face of human pressures, God orchestrated just what's needed
- 2. We serve a God that moves pieces <u>ahead of</u> <u>time</u>, in order to perform His plan at the <u>right time</u>

Read Vs 23-24

- 1. While waiting for the promise of receiving their own land, God made them grow in numbers
- 2. All the waiting for God's promises to be fulfilled, was for His glory and their benefit

Read Vs 25-36

- 1. Read II Cor 4:17 These things are difficult for a time, but they're working greater things
- 2. To understand why God would plague Egypt w/ all these, we must understand that they each speak against a false god in Egypt

Read Vs 37-38

- 1. While waiting for the promise of receiving their own land, God made them fruitful & prosper
- 2. The difficulties working out great things that they could not have received otherwise

Read Vs 39-41

- 1. This one is different in the sense that God didn't put them thru this trial, their unbelief is the reason that wandered for 40 years
- 2. Yet God STILL provided while they waited Read Vs 42-45
 - 1. All this so Israel might inherit the land in order to serve God in truth, justice & the Israeli way
 - 2. Of course this will lead them to the 3rd promise given to Abraham, that of the Messiah to come & actually keeping the Law thru belief in Jesus
